# Narrative:

On August 15, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Al Bansky (Bansky) received Ohio BCI Laboratory report(s) for items of evidence submitted on April 19, 2022, for scientific analysis (laboratory case number 22-33458). The report originated from the Chemistry section of the laboratory and was authored by Forensic Scientist Erin Miller. The items relevant to this report, which had previously been submitted, were as follows:

- 1. Plastic bag containing unknown substance (CS23)
- 2. Plastic bag containing unknown substance (CS24)

SA Bansky reviewed the laboratory report and noted the following:

- 1. (CS23) Two plastic bags found on James Sheets; each contained a crystalline substance, found to be methamphetamine.
- 2. (CS24) White substance found on James Sheets; found to contain cocaine.
