Narrative:

On Thursday, October 23, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Amanda North (SA North) received requested records and recordings from Grove City Police Department (GCPD). SA Rick Ward had previously requested all dispatch records, audio recordings (radio, 911, and phone), mobile data terminal (MDT) communications, and any other dispatch/communications-related information pertaining to the officer-involved critical incident (OICI) which occurred on October 8, 2025, involving officers from GCPD and subject Dominique Byrdsong (Byrdsong). As a result of that request, the following items were received and reviewed:

Radio Traffic Recordings:

Dispatch recordings of radio traffic related to this incident were provided to BCI in individual audio format. Please refer to these audio files for specific details. Upon review of dispatch audio files, the following was noted:

- Grove City Dispatch to 146, requested all available units to respond to 3810 Louise Court on an "8"
- Dispatch advised that the homeowner arrived home to find an individual inside the residence, and had a "33" (firearm) in his waistband
- Description of individual provided as male Hispanic
- Homeowner called from 3825 Louise Court
- [REDACTED], 145, 167, 66, 44 on scene
- Request to look up DOT # on suspect vehicle in driveway
- Dispatch advised vehicle in driveway had been there since the previous night, driver was questioned about his presence- described as Black male wearing ballcap, grey and black striped shirt and blue backpack
- 1245 en route
- Vehicle identified as commercial vehicle from a closed business on Frank Road

- SRT cleared the residence
- BCI is on scene
- VIN check on suspect vehicle was reported stolen out of Pickaway County
- Pickaway County advised that suspect left his vehicle behind; vehicle held

911 Calls:

- October 8, 2025: Dispatch received a call from a male homeowner who stated that he owns the residence at 3810 Louise Court, in Grove City, Ohio, that he does not currently live in the residence but stopped by to check on it, and that there was a person inside the residence that he does not know. The male stated that while talking to the unknown person, the person pulled up his shirt and had a gun in his waistband. The caller then left the residence. The caller described the person inside his residence as a male Hispanic/bi-racial. The unknown male was "pilfering" items from the home and placing them into a bag. The unknown male told the caller that the unknown male was the nephew of the caller's wife. The caller stated that he is currently at 3825 Louise Court. The caller stated that the unknown male was wearing sweatpants, possibly Black, and a Gray t-shirt.
