**Narrative:**

On September 19, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Chuck Moran (Moran) began reviewing a body-worn camera (BWC) video file for this case.

SAS Moran located one BWC video file on the SIU shared drive in the Reference Item F folder for Wadsworth Police Department (WPD) [REDACTED]. It was labeled:

SAS Moran made a working copy of the video and placed it in a folder. The working copy of the video was used for the review.

SAS Moran imported the video into Amped Replay for review.

Activity/Notes	██████████ was driving his police vehicle. Another officer was seated in the front passenger seat.

Activity/Notes	██████████ and ██████████ exited the police vehicle on High Street near Durling Drive. They began running toward Durling Drive.

Note: ██████████ and ██████████ ran south on Durling Drive. ██████████ confirmed the address with dispatch and dispatch radioed that the subject made "threats in the past using the 40." Dispatch radioed that the subject was "sitting in the backyard in a chair with a holster."

Activity/Notes	WPD officers approached the front yard of a neighboring residence (north of 223 Durling Drive) and encountered a female near the front of the residence. ██████████ and Seiler moved around the southwest corner of the neighboring residence while ██████████ and ██████████ moved south through the front yard of the neighboring residence.

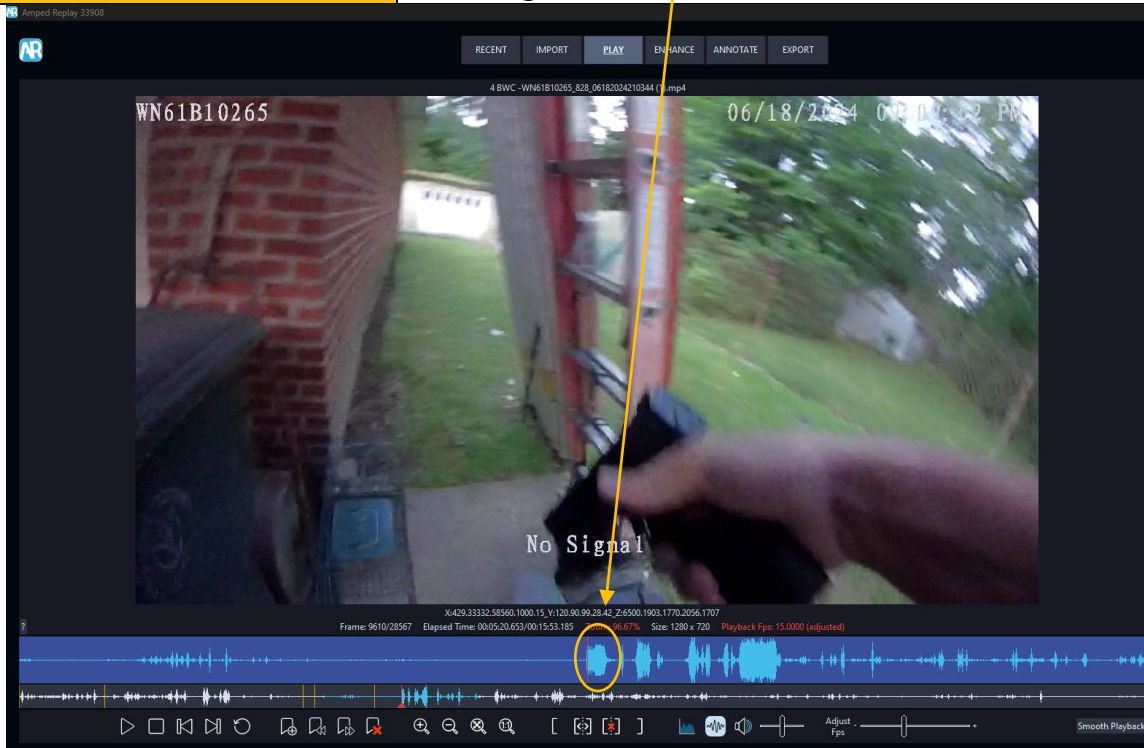

Activity/Notes	This was the approximate frame of the first loud cracking sound (possible first gunshot) heard and observed on the audio waveform bar. (In the frames immediately prior, a male's voice was heard saying, "Hey! Hey! Don't. Don't. Don't. Put it down.") Multiple loud cracking sounds were heard in rapid succession (possibly gunshots). The audio stream recorded the sounds, but each loud cracking sound (possible gunshot) was indistinguishable (likely due to volume, rapid succession, BWC audio microphone capabilities, etc.). The sounds were observed on the audio waveform bar in Amped Replay as a large spike. See image below.

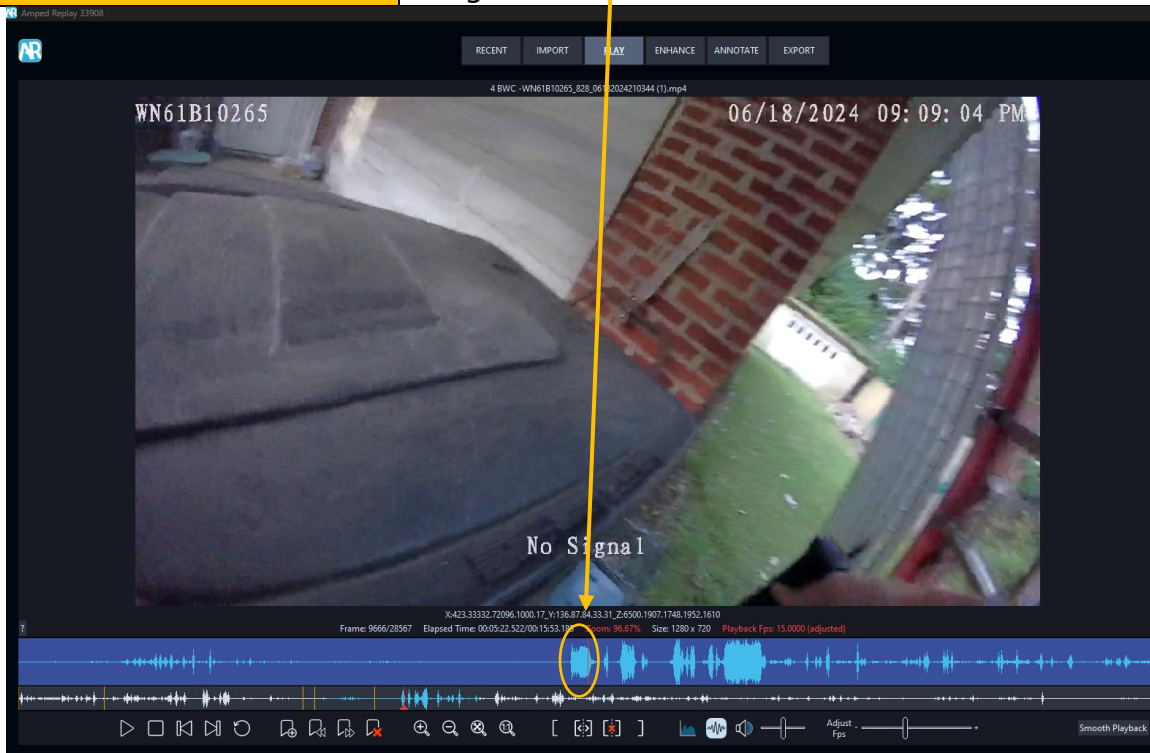

Activity/Notes	This was the approximate last frame of the loud cracking sounds heard (possible gunshots). In the frames between 9610 and this frame, multiple loud cracking sounds were heard in rapid succession (possibly gunshots). The audio stream recorded the sounds, but each loud cracking sound (possible gunshot) was indistinguishable (likely due to volume, rapid succession, BWC audio microphone capabilities, etc.). The sounds were observed on the audio waveform bar in Amped Replay as a large spike. See image below.

Activity/Notes	[REDACTED] moved into the backyard and approached the area where [REDACTED] and Seiler were standing. They were near the subject, Shannon Sloan (Sloan), who was lying face down on the ground. Sloan had a black colored shoulder holster visible on his upper right side.

Activity/Notes	[REDACTED] and Seiler handcuffed Sloan. Another officer, likely [REDACTED] said, "I got the gun. Unloading it."

Activity/Notes	[REDACTED] and Seiler finished handcuffing Sloan. [REDACTED] said, "It's right here. Hey. Round out of the chamber. I don't have a bodycam on. Everybody's on?" An officer replied, "Yes." A dark object, possibly a pistol, was observed on the grass near [REDACTED]'s right foot.

Activity/Notes	██████████ told Seiler to “pat him (Sloan) down for weapons.” Seiler rolled Sloan onto his left side and checked for additional weapons. Sloan made groaning sounds but did not say anything. The officers began rendering medical aid to Sloan. A black shoulder holster was observed on Sloan’s upper left side.

Activity/Notes	██████████ instructed an officer to remove one of the handcuffs from Sloan since he did not have any additional weapons. An officer removed one of the handcuffs from Sloan.

Activity/Notes	██████████ instructed ██████████ to “secure” the firearms. ██████████ leaned over to secure a dark colored, semi-auto pistol that was unloaded in the grass (same area as dark colored object noted in the previous frames described above). The ammunition magazine was on the grass next to the pistol.

Activity/Notes	██████████ picked up the semi-auto pistol and the ammunition magazine from the ground.

Activity/Notes	██████████ placed the semi-auto pistol and ammunition magazine on a concrete area under the garage overhang.

Activity/Notes	██████████ walked back to the same area in grass and picked up two additional ammunition magazines. He asked, "Who's mags are these? Are these his mags?"

Activity/Notes	██████████ placed the magazines on the concrete near the semi-auto pistol and other magazine. In the previous frames, Seiler confirmed that the two additional magazines were Sloan's.

Activity/Notes	██████████ instructed officers to "secure" their weapons. Multiple officers were rendering medical aid to Sloan.

Activity/Notes	██████████ stated, "He did not fire a shot." Multiple WPD officers continued rendering medical aid to Sloan.

Note: Multiple paramedics arrived and began assisting the WPD officers with rendering medical aid to Sloan.

Activity/Notes	██████████ removed the single handcuff that was around Sloan's right wrist.

Note: Paramedics and officers eventually stopped rendering medical aid when it was clear that Sloan was deceased. Officer began securing the scene.
