On September 19, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Chuck Moran (Moran) began reviewing a body-worn camera (BWC) video file for this case.

SAS Moran located one BWC video file on the SIU shared drive in the Reference Item F folder for Wadsworth Police Department (WPD)

SAS Moran made a working copy of the video and placed it in a folder. The working copy of the video was used for the review.

SAS Moran imported the video into Amped Replay for review.





	holster was observed on Sloan's upper left side.
