Careful consideration of these leases, in connection with the history thereof stated in your letter, convinces me that their purpose is within section 3209-1, as amended in 105 O. L., page 6. It is noted that you deem the terms and conditions thereof to be for the best interest of the beneficiaries of those lands. It is noted that the authority of Mr. S. M. Warden, president of said company, to sign the lease, does not appear.

However, the execution of the lease by the president of the company under the seal of the corporation raises a presumption that such execution was authorized by the directors of the corporation. See Railroad vs. Carter, 26 O. S., 246; Hayes vs. Galion, 29 O. S., 330. Therefore, this is not considered to be a material defect and said leases are therefore approved.
