I then conferred with Sgt. Reese after which I proceeded to the scene and commenced with the following investigation.

**ON SCENE:** Homicide Unit Detectives Raymond Diaz #1001, Timothy Cramer #346, Thelemon Powell #2062 and Shane Bauhof #1637 responded to the scene to commence with the investigation. Commander Brown, Homicide Unit Supervisors Commander [REDACTED] Pillow. Sgt. Reese and Sgt. Gomez were on scene.



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

**INVESTIGATION:** On Thursday June 2, 2022 at 1734 hours, Fourth district received a radio broadcast at 3495 E.98<sup>th</sup> Street #703 for a male shot. The officers received additional information that CMHA Officers were involved in a use of deadly force.

Cleveland EMS unit #7, arrived on scene and transported the suspect to University Hospital where he was pronounced deceased at 1818 hours by Doctor Rushing. Officer [REDACTED] was transported by Cleveland EMS #28 where he was confined for his injuries.

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The FIT team was Called-Up, after conferring with Sgt. Gomez she advised that Detectives Legg, Hudson, Powell, Diaz, Cramer, and I respond to the scene and Detectives Bauhof and Borden respond to University Hospital.

Internal Affairs and CSRU responded to the scene and hospital.


Detectives Legg, Diaz, and Powell with CSRU Detectives Edge, Emerick, Hale and Sgt. Rini, processed the scene at Union Square. CSRU Detective Manson responded to the hospital.

Preliminary investigation revealed On Thursday June 2, 2022, CMHA Police Officer [REDACTED] and Sgt. [REDACTED] received a radio broadcast to respond to 3495 E.98<sup>th</sup> Street for a male throwing objects off of an apartment balcony. When they arrived on scene they observed multiple objects (Large flat screen T.V., mirrors, hatchet, phone, lamps, furniture, cans of food and other miscellaneous property) on the street and grass of the apartment building.

Officer [REDACTED] and Sgt. [REDACTED] entered the building, went to apartment #703 and knocked on the door. The Officers entered the apartment while announcing their presence multiple times "POLICE DEPARMENT".

When the officers entered the apartment they observed blood on the walls, a large fish tank that was shattered and with water pouring out of the tank. The apartment was in disarray with the balcony glass door was shattered. They also saw and heard running water and it appeared that the apartment was being flooded.

The officers approached the area where the water was running (the bathroom off the bedroom). At that time they came in contact with Demond Eskridge who was sitting

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naked in the bathtub with water over flowing from the tub. Eskridge stood up and stated "You got a problem". Eskridge then charged Officer [REDACTED] punching him in the face. Sgt. [REDACTED] tried to hold onto Eskridge's arm when P.O. [REDACTED] stated that Eskridge was grabbing his gun.

Eskridge was able to take control of PO. [REDACTED] firearm. PO. [REDACTED] attempted to get his gun back, Eskridge began to bite PO. [REDACTED] left index finger. PO. [REDACTED] yelled "He has my gun". Sgt. [REDACTED] then deployed his Taser hitting Eskridge.


Eskridge pointed PO. [REDACTED] firearm at Sgt. [REDACTED] and fired one round just missing his head.

During the struggle PO. [REDACTED] was attempting to get his finger out of Eskridge's mouth and tried to grab his gun back when the magazine dropped out PO. [REDACTED] gun. Eskridge continued to pull the trigger of the gun, he was unable to fire because the magazine became unseated during the struggle.

PO. [REDACTED] tried to disarm Eskridge, they both fell onto the bed with Eskridge on top of PO. [REDACTED] attacking him. Sgt. [REDACTED] fired his service weapon striking Eskridge in the back.

Sgt. [REDACTED] tripped and fell to the ground. Eskridge charged Sgt. [REDACTED] and was on top of Sgt. [REDACTED] and attempted to take his gun.

After being shot by Sgt. [REDACTED] the gun that Eskridge was firing fell to the ground. Sgt. [REDACTED] was on the floor and Eskridge was on top of him lying on the left side of Sgt. [REDACTED] body. They were both in threshold of the bedroom doorway.

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Sgt. [REDACTED] was trying to keep his gun away from Eskridge. Eskridge kept trying to grab the gun from Sgt. [REDACTED]. PO. [REDACTED] leaned over the two of them and said to Sgt. [REDACTED] "Give Me Your Gun". Sgt. [REDACTED] was able to hand his firearm to PO. [REDACTED] fired one round into Eskridge left upper shoulder area.

Sgt. [REDACTED] and PO. [REDACTED] were able to handcuff Eskridge and Sgt. [REDACTED] performed First Aid until he was relieved by CMHA P.D. Sgt. Holder who arrived on scene to assist. Cleveland EMS Unit # 7 transported Eskridge to U.H. where he was pronounced him deceased at 1818 hours.


Cleveland EMS Unit #28 transported PO [REDACTED] to University Hospital where he will be confined. PO [REDACTED] is awaiting a CAT scan of his head and X-rays on his left hand. A portion of his left index finger was bitten off by Eskridge. PO. [REDACTED] was photographed and his uniform was collected for evidence.

Sgt. [REDACTED] and PO. [REDACTED] turned over their body cameras to be downloaded at the CMHA Police Department. Detective Lentz went to CMHA with CMHA Commander Burdyslaw to download the videos and collect Sgt. [REDACTED] uniform for evidence. Sgt. Drew Taser was downloaded and collect for evidence.

The officers' service weapons were inspected and collected with the magazines and rounds for evidence.

The Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office Doctor Gilson and Investigator Strang responded to the scene to conduct their investigation.

Sgt. Reese briefed Cuyahoga County Prosecutor Saleh Awadallah on the FIT call-up.

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
**WALKTHROUGH:**

A "Walk Through" was conducted. Present during the "Walk Through" Homicide Unit Sgt. Reese and Sgt. Gomez, Detective Legg, and I, from CMHA Sgt. Wilcox, from Internal Affairs Sgt. Sheehan, from CSRU Sgt. Rini, Doctor Gilson and FOP Attorney Adam Chaloupka.

The "Walk Through" was captured on my body camera and was downloaded onto Evidence.Com.

During the "Walk Through" Sgt. [REDACTED] reported the following:

- Sgt. [REDACTED] stated he and PO. [REDACTED] got a call for a man throwing stuff out his apartment window.
- Sgt. [REDACTED] stated when they arrived on scene the saw stuff all over the ground. He was able to determine that it was coming from the 7<sup>th</sup> floor, apartment #703
- Sgt. [REDACTED] stated that PO. [REDACTED] and him went to the apartment #703 the door must have been be slightly ajar because when PO. [REDACTED] touched the door it opened up.
- Sgt. [REDACTED] stated that the apartment was completely trashed and flooded. PO. [REDACTED] walks in first as we called out they were in the unit. They go into the bedroom that's when PO. [REDACTED] was bum-rushed by the suspect. The suspect was on top of [REDACTED] trying to grab his gun.
- Sgt. [REDACTED] stated "I grabbed my Taser, as I'm trying to pull the suspect off of PO. [REDACTED]. That's when I deployed my Taser hitting the suspect in his back. The suspect had PO. [REDACTED] gun and I heard one gun shot. PO. [REDACTED] and the suspect ended up on

the bed. The Suspect was on top of PO. [REDACTED] when I fired a shot at the suspect. The suspect charged me and we end up on the floor, with the suspect lying on top of my left side. I believed that the suspect still had PO. [REDACTED] gun. That's when PO. [REDACTED] told me to hand him my gun. That is when PO. [REDACTED] fired one round into the suspect".

- Sgt. [REDACTED] stated that that the suspect was still fighting but they were able to handcuff the male, began CPR, and call for EMS.


I asked Sgt. Drew how many shots were fired.

- Sgt. [REDACTED] stated that three shots were fired, the suspect was the first to fire one round from PO. [REDACTED] gun, then I fired one round from my service weapon, then PO. [REDACTED] fired the last round from my service weapon.

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
