Narrative:

On Friday, December 27, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Chuck Moran (SAS Moran) reviewed video files from the Dollar General store located at 1370 Belmont Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio 44504. SAS Moran was informed that the videos were from the surveillance cameras located inside the store. The 14 videos were located in the BCI case file in evidence.com in the folder labeled as Reference Item E. The videos were:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

These videos were from an incident that occurred on September 10, 2024, involving a male subject, Shane Linderman (Linderman), a female victim, Maureen Stopperich (Stopperich), and Youngstown Police Department (YPD) Officer [REDACTED] that resulted in an officer-involved critical incident (shooting).

RECOMMENDED ORDER FOR REVIEW

It is recommended that the viewer review the videos, images, and reports in this order:

1. Original CCTV videos at full speed and individually.
2. Bookmarked images from Amped Replat review.
3. Amped Replay reports.

REVIEW

SAS Moran imported the videos into Amped Replay for review. SAS Moran generated bookmarked images for each video and Amped Replay reports for each video.

WMP_BACK_ASLE_E_EXT_2024-09-10_17_25_46_795

This camera angle covered an aisle inside the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 809 frames and was 00:00:53:866 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

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Multiple officers were observed walking in and out of the aisles and along the back aisle. This camera did not show the shooting portion of the incident. No derivatives were generated from Amped Replay for this video file.

This camera angle covered the interior entry/exit doors near the front of the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 13385 frames and was 00:15:55:992 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

Employees and customers were observed near the front doors. Some of the store employees appeared frantic and hurried in their movements. They eventually closed and locked the front exterior automatic door as they directed customers outside the store. Some of the employees appeared to be using their cell phones.

Amped Replay was used to generate bookmarked images as derivatives for this video file. The derivatives were for demonstrative purposes only. The frame numbers for the bookmarked images are detailed below:

Activity	Two officers exited the store.

Activity	The officer who initially entered the store (frame 6472), then exited the store (frame 8707), re-entered the store. He appeared to have a red-colored substance on his left hand (possibly blood).

Activity	Another officer entered the store.

Frame	9768
Activity	Another officer entered the store.

Frame	9819
Activity	Three additional officers entered the store.

Frame	10410
Activity	An officer exited the store.

Frame	10576
Activity	Another officer entered the store.

Frame	10909
Activity	Another officer entered the store.

Frame	11015
Activity	Two medics entered the store.

Frame	11084
Activity	An officer entered the store.

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Frame	11230
Activity	Another officer entered the store.

Frame	11597
Activity	Two officers exited the store.

Frame	11769
Activity	Another medic entered the store, and an officer exited the store.

Frame	11852
Activity	Two officers exited the store.

Frame	12024
Activity	An officer in plain clothes entered the store.

Frame	12372
Activity	Two officers (one of the officers was the officer observed in frames 6472, 8707, and 9665) exited the store and another medic with a stretcher entered the store.

Frame	12849
Activity	An officer and a medic exited the store.

Frame	13170
Activity	Medics transported a person (likely Stopperich) on a stretcher out of the store. The person's upper body was covered in a red-colored substance (likely blood).

This camera did not show the shooting portion of the incident. The bookmarked images noted above were exported to the "Derivatives" folder and placed in the "Bkmrks - DSD" folder. The report was placed in the "Reports" folder.

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[WMP_ENTRY_DOORS_2024-09-10_17_14_00_705](#)

This camera angle covered the interior entry/exit doors near the front of the store (from a different angle but similar to the video reviewed above (WMP_DSD_2024-09-10_17_14_00_735). There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 26684 frames and was 00:14:49:433 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

This video file showed similar activity to the activity described in the video reviewed above (WMP_DSD_2024-09-10_17_14_00_735). This camera did not show the shooting portion of the incident. No derivatives were generated from Amped Replay for this video file.

[WMP_EXIT_VIEW_2024-09-10_17_14_00_700](#)

This camera angle covered the interior entry/exit doors near the front of the store (from a different angle but similar to the video reviewed above WMP_DSD_2024-09-10_17_14_00_735). There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 12974 frames and was 00:14:24:858 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

This video file showed similar activity to the activity described in the video reviewed above (WMP_DSD_2024-09-10_17_14_00_735). This camera did not show the shooting portion of the incident. No derivatives were generated from Amped Replay for this video file.

[WMP_FRONT_EXTERIOR_2024-09-10_17_14_00_700](#)

This camera angle covered an area outside of the store (possibly the rear of the store). There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 16183 frames and was 00:09:17:987 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

There was nothing observed that was relevant to the shooting portion of the incident. No derivatives were generated from Amped Replay for this video file.

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[WMP_HEALTH_BEAUTY1_2024-09-10_17_14_00_710](#)

This camera angle covered an area of an aisle inside the store and faced the area where the front registers were located. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 12868 frames and was 00:14:17:791 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

Amped Replay was used to generate bookmarked images as derivatives for this video file. The derivatives were for demonstrative purposes only. The frame numbers for the bookmarked images are detailed below:

Activity	A male, likely Shane Linderman (Linderman), approached a female, likely Maureen Stopperich (Stopperich), and the end of the aisle near the registers.

Frame	740
Activity	Linderman and Stopperich appeared to be speaking to each other and Linderman had an object under his left arm.

Frame	768
Activity	Stopperich used her right hand and grabbed the item that was under Linderman's left arm. Linderman grabbed Stopperich with both of his hands/arms.

Frame	803
Activity	Stopperich tried to push Linderman away with her right arm, but Linderman did not let go of Stopperich.

Frame	866
Activity	Stopperich again tried to pull away from Linderman but he held onto her arms with both of his hands.

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Frame	915
Activity	Stopperich was able to pull away from Linderman and she began walking down the aisle (toward the camera). Linderman followed next to her and reached out with his hands toward Stopperich. (It was apparent that Stopperich had an item in packaging in her right hand that was the item she initially took away from Linderman).

Frame	925
Activity	Stopperich and Linderman continued walking down the aisle (toward the camera). Stopperich held the item above her head (it appeared to have three dark colored handles protruding from the bottom of the packaging).

Frame	1402
Activity	Store employees began running away from the next aisle over.

Frame	1415
Activity	There was movement observed in the next aisle over (right side of video). One of the objects that moved appeared to be the top of Linderman's head. There was possibly an impact near a product display stand because the display stand started moving.

Frame	1941
Activity	Employees appeared to be moving quickly throughout the front of the store.

Frame	2443
Activity	Employees continued moving quickly and one employee used a long stick (broom) to move something (possibly Linderman) in the aisle.

Frame	3237
Activity	Employees moved toward the front doors. One of the employees had both of his hands on the top of his head.

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Frame	5940
Activity	Two officers entered the store and moved toward the aisle where Linderman (and possibly Stopperich) were last seen.

Frame	6252
Activity	One of the officers was out of the camera's field-of-view (aisle display blocking view) and the other officer had his pistol pointed down the aisle.

Frame	6270
Activity	The visible officer suddenly moved behind and end aisle display.

Frame	6669
Activity	Linderman stood up in the aisle and moved toward the officer(s).

Frame	6699
Activity	Both officers moved backwards and Linderman fell to the ground near the end of the aisle. (The plain clothes officer was now visible and the uniform officer was not visible because he moved behind and end display.)

Frame	6732
Activity	The officer continued moving backwards and to his right. Linderman was on the ground and it appeared that his arms were moving and he was moving back and forth on his back. In the previous frames, the officer was maneuvering his pistol, possibly in an effort to clear a malfunction.

Frame	6816
Activity	The officer holstered his pistol and approached Linderman to begin handcuffing him.

Frame	7142
Activity	The plain clothes officer stood up and went to the other aisle (possibly to check Stopperich). The uniformed officer stood near Linderman.

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Frame	7438
Activity	The uniformed officer rolled Linderman onto his back. Linderman was covered in a red-colored substance (likely blood).

Multiple other officers and medics arrived at the store. There was activity in the aisle (on the right side of the screen, likely where Stopperich was located). It was likely that Linderman was immediately or quickly deceased after the shooting.

The bookmarked images noted above were exported to the "Derivatives" folder and placed in the "Bkmrks - Health Beauty 1" folder. The report was placed in the "Reports" folder.

This camera angle covered an aisle inside the store and the aisle was intersected by another aisle. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 5309 frames and was 00:05:53:929 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

Amped Replay was used to generate bookmarked images as derivatives for this video file. The derivatives were for demonstrative purposes only. The frame numbers for the bookmarked images are detailed below:

Activity	Linderman walked into an aisle and looked at the shelves.

Frame	238
Activity	Linderman walked out of the aisle. It appeared that he was holding an item in his right hand.

Frame	284
Activity	Linderman walked down the aisle (facing the camera) and it appeared he had a package in his right hand. At least two dark colored objects (likely handles) protruded from the end of the package.

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Frame	857
Activity	Linderman and Stopperich moved into the view of the camera in the aisle. Linderman reached toward Stopperich with his right hand. Stopperich was holding a package (possibly containing three knives) with dark handles protruding from the bottom of the package in her right hand.

Frame	923
Activity	After Linderman reached for the package of knives and Stopperich did not give it to him, Linderman walked away from her down the intersecting aisle.

Frame	951
Activity	Linderman walked into the aisle where he likely obtained the knife package from and Stopperich followed.

Frame	1101
Activity	Linderman was observed moving in the aisle (movements appeared to be rapid) and Stopperich was out of view of the camera (blocked by the shelving in the aisle). Linderman's movements The aisle shelving was moving back and forth likely from the movement of Linderman and Stopperich in the aisle).

Frame	1171
Activity	The motion and activity between Linderman and Stopperich in the aisle caused another person (a female) to walk out of a neighboring aisle to look into the aisle that Linderman and Stopperich were in.

Frame	1186
Activity	Stopperich began moving out of the aisle. She appeared to be leaning over and had her right hand/arm up near her neck and chest as she moved.

Frame	1198
Activity	Linderman followed Stopperich out of the aisle. His shirt appeared to be moved/torn on his left side.

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Frame	1202
Activity	Linderman followed Stopperich out of the aisle. His shirt appeared to be moved/torn on his left side. The female observer moved backwards and away from Linderman.

Frame	1224
Activity	Linderman and Stopperich moved out of the camera view. An employee moved into view of the camera down the main aisle (possibly in response to the activity between Linderman and Stopperich).

Frame	1264
Activity	The employee moved into the aisle and out of the camera's field-of-view toward the area where Linderman and Stopperich were.

Frame	1369
Activity	The employee moved back and into the camera view (away from the area where Linderman and Stopperich were).

Frame	1404
Activity	The female observer (likely another employee) moved down the aisle and out of the camera view.

Frame	1963
Activity	An officer moved into the aisle and checked the other aisle and area.

Frame	2066
Activity	The officer moved down the aisle and out of the camera view.

Frame	2378
Activity	Another officer moved into the aisle and checked the area.

Frame	2468
Activity	Two more officers moved into the aisle and checked the area.

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The remainder of the video file showed officers moving in and out of the aisle. Nothing relevant was observed/noted.

The bookmarked images noted above were exported to the "Derivatives" folder and placed in the "Bkmrks - Health Beauty 2" folder. The report was placed in the "Reports" folder.

[WMP_MENS_UNDERWEAR_2024-09-10_17_14_00_745](#)

This camera angle covered an aisle inside the store and partially overlooked the front of the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 11583 frames and was 00:12:52:192 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

Amped Replay was used to generate bookmarked images as derivatives for this video file. The derivatives were for demonstrative purposes only. The frame numbers for the bookmarked images are detailed below:

Activity	Linderman walked near the front aisle product endcap.

Frame	198
Activity	Linderman moved to a middle intersecting aisle and spoke with a female employee in a black shirt.

Frame	220
Activity	The female employee pointed to another aisle and Linderman began to move toward that aisle.

Frame	429
Activity	Linderman removed a package/item from the aisle shelf and walked out of the aisle.

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Frame	1114
Activity	Linderman moved into the camera view and into the aisle where he picked up the package/item.

Frame	1137
Activity	Linderman was in the aisle and Stopperich moved into the camera view and into the aisle.

Frame	1294
Activity	In this frame (and previous frames), Stopperich moved backwards against the shelving and it was possible that Linderman used his left hand to hold/pull Stopperich's head/hair backwards and upwards.

Frame	1317
Activity	In this frame (and previous frames), Stopperich moved backwards against the shelving, and it was possible that Linderman used his left hand to hold/pull Stopperich's head/hair backwards and upwards. It appeared that Linderman made other motions, possibly with his right side.

Frame	1339
Activity	In this frame (and previous frames), Stopperich moved forward and appeared to be bent forward at her waist. It was unclear what Linderman was doing in the frame. The female employee wearing the black shirt moved from her aisle toward the aisle that Linderman and Stopperich were in.

Frame	1391
Activity	Stopperich moved down the aisle (toward the camera) and Linderman followed behind her.

Frame	1402
Activity	Stopperich moved down the aisle (toward the camera) and Linderman followed behind her.

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Frame	1415
Activity	Stopperich went to the ground near the end of the aisle (lower right portion of viewing screen). Linderman was near her and might have taken her to the ground.

Frame	1454
Activity	Linderman went to the ground with Stopperich. There was motion and activity on the ground, but it was not clear on the video. The aisle product endcap moved due to the activity on the ground.

Frame	1486
Activity	Linderman and Stopperich were still on the ground and there was movement and activity. An employee with a red sweatshirt on entered the aisle and appeared to reach out/grab Linderman.

Frame	1509
Activity	The employee moved away from Linderman and Stopperich.

Frame	1640
Activity	The employee moved down another aisle and reapproached Linderman and Stopperich from another angle. Linderman and Stopperich were still on the ground and there was movement and activity.

Frame	1773
Activity	Linderman appeared to be kneeling over Stopperich on the ground. Both of Linderman's arms were extended near Stopperich's upper body.

Frame	1847
Activity	Linderman appeared to be kneeling over Stopperich on the ground. Both of Linderman's arms were extended near Stopperich's upper body. Stopperich appeared to be moving/struggling on the ground underneath Linderman's hands/arms/body.

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Frame	1922
Activity	Linderman moved slightly upward and almost out of the camera view. Stopperich was still moving/struggling on the ground. Her face/neck/upper body was discolored (possibly red from blood) and she reached her right hand up toward her head/neck area.

Frame	2056
Activity	Linderman moved his upper body back over Stopperich's upper body as she continued to move/struggle on the ground.

Frame	2141
Activity	Linderman looked in the direction of the employees nearby while he had his hands/arms extended near Stopperich's upper body.

Frame	3208
Activity	Linderman continued moving his upper body and outstretched arms/hands over Stopperich's upper body, possibly near her head/neck area. In this frame, Linderman's right hand was observed moving to grab Stopperich's head/neck area.

Frame	3578
Activity	In this frame, Linderman's right forearm/hand was observed and it was discolored (shining and possibly red colored from blood). In the previous frames, his right hand moved rapidly away from Stopperich's upper body.

Frame	4142
Activity	Linderman pulled Stopperich's upper body upward and off the ground.

Frame	4287
Activity	Linderman stood over Stopperich's upper body as he pushed her upper body back to the ground. Linderman made pulling motions with his right hand.

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Frame	4365
Activity	Linderman knelt on Stopperich's upper body with his right knee.

Frame	4680
Activity	A light appeared (possibly a weapon-mounted light/flashlight near Linderman's right thigh. Linderman turned to his right and looked in a direction toward the front of the store (possibly towards an officer). There appeared to be a dark colored portion on the front of Linderman's shirt and on his hands (possibly red colored, blood).

Frame	4708
Activity	The light turned off/was not visible in this frame. Linderman's right arm was visible and was possibly covered in blood.

Frame	4993
Activity	In this frame, an officer moved to his left and into the camera view. Linderman raised his right arm that was possibly covered in blood. In the previous frames, Linderman's mouth was moving (possibly speaking to officers).

Frame	5388
Activity	Linderman stood up and moved toward the officer(s). Linderman's front side and arms were possibly covered in blood. In this frame, Linderman's right hand moved upward and frontward for his right side. An officer moved to his left and away from Linderman. In the previous frames, Linderman's mouth was moving and he stood up.

Frame	5509
Activity	An officer had his Taser drawn and removed handcuffs from his vest. Linderman was not in the camera view.

Frame	5781
Activity	Another officer moved into the camera view and appeared to check on Stopperich who was still on the ground.

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Officers rendered aid to Stopperich until paramedics arrived.

Frame	11167
Activity	Paramedics placed Stopperich on a stretcher and removed her from the scene.

The remainder of the video file showed officers arriving and moving throughout the scene. Nothing relevant was observed/noted.

The bookmarked images noted above were exported to the "Derivatives" folder and placed in the "Bkmrks - Mens Underwear" folder. The report was placed in the "Reports" folder.

[WMP_OFFICE_2024-09-10_17_14_00_725](#)

This camera angle covered an interior office inside the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 17568 frames and was 00:09:45:600 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

An employee was inside the office during most of the video. The employee used her phone and appeared to look at the multiplex surveillance camera monitor in the office (possibly during the event). This camera did not show the shooting portion of the incident. No derivatives were generated from Amped Replay for this video file.

[WMP_RECEIVING_2024-09-10_17_14_09_395](#)

This camera angle covered the exterior side of the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 3057 frames and was 00:03:23:797 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

A marked police vehicle arrived; an officer exited the cruiser and walked around the side of the building. Some time later, an ambulance arrived and drove around the side of the building. This camera did not show the shooting portion of the incident. No derivatives were generated from Amped Replay for this video file.

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[WMP_REFRIGERATION_2024-09-10_17_15_15_940](#)

This camera angle covered an aisle inside the store that had coolers/refrigerators in it. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 1379 frames and was 00:01:31:932 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

The video showed officers walking in the aisle, likely after the incident. This camera did not show the shooting portion of the incident. No derivatives were generated from Amped Replay for this video file.

This camera angle covered the front register and entry/exit doors of the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 26981 frames and was 00:14:59:366 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

Amped Replay was used to generate bookmarked images as derivatives for this video file. The derivatives were for demonstrative purposes only. The frame numbers for the bookmarked images are detailed below:

Activity	Linderman walked near the front of the store.

Multiple employees moved near the front of the store (possible that Linderman was attacking Stopperich in an aisle out of the camera's field-of-view). The employees went in and out of the store.

Frame	13008
Activity	Two officers entered the store.

Frame	14644
Activity	The uniformed officer moved into the camera's field-of-view on the right side near an aisle. The officer had a Taser in his hand.

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Frame	17064
Activity	Two additional uniformed officers entered the store.

Multiple other officers and medics arrived at the store. The aisle where the incident occurred was not in the camera's field-of-view.

Frame	26548
Activity	Medics transported Stopperich out of the store on a stretcher.

The bookmarked images noted above were exported to the "Derivatives" folder and placed in the "Bkmrks - Register 1" folder. The report was placed in the "Reports" folder.

[WMP_REGISTER_2_SAFE_2024-09-10_17_14_00_720](#)

This camera angle covered another front register inside the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 25389 frames and was 00:14:06:300 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

Amped Replay was used to generate bookmarked images as derivatives for this video file. The derivatives were for demonstrative purposes only. The frame numbers for the bookmarked images are detailed below:

Activity	Stopperich stood near the front corner register.

Frame	1119
Activity	Linderman approached Stopperich and he had an item/package in his left hand.

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Frame	1366
Activity	Stopperich walked away from Linderman and out of the camera's field-of view. Linderman walked toward the register. He had the item/package in his left hand. The package had three dark (possibly black) colored handles extending from the bottom of the packaging (possibly knives).

Frame	1494
Activity	A person (likely Stopperich) removed the item/package with their right hand from Linderman's left hand.

Frame	1508
Activity	Linderman reached forward to possibly grab the person (likely Stopperich).

Frame	1603
Activity	Stopperich moved into the camera's field-of view. Linderman and Stopperich were close to each other. Stopperich had the item/package in her right hand. Linderman possibly held Stopperich with his left hand.

Frame	1627
Activity	Stopperich tried to move backwards and Linderman grabbed Stopperich's left shoulder with his right hand.

Frame	1725
Activity	Stopperich raised the item package upward with her right hand and she began moving to her right. Linderman appeared to be holding/grabbing Stopperich with his hands.

Stopperich and Linderman moved out of the camera's field-of-view. Some time later, multiple employees moved from the registers toward the aisles in the store (Linderman possibly attacking Stopperich in an aisle out of the camera's field-of-view). Employees also moved near the register and were looking at the aisles nearby.

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Frame	11528
Activity	Two officers moved near the front register aisle.

Frame	13042
Activity	A non-uniformed officer moved backwards into the camera's field-of-view. A shopping basket slid along the floor.

Frame	13110
Activity	The non-uniformed officer moved to his right and out of the camera's field-of-view. A person's head (likely Linderman) was on the floor and possibly had blood on it.

Frame	13634
Activity	The non-uniformed officer knelt down on the ground near the person (likely Linderman).

Activity	The uniformed officer possibly rolled the person (likely Linderman) onto his back. The person's head (likely Linderman) was on the floor and possibly had blood on it.

Frame	15628
Activity	Two additional uniformed officers entered the store.

Multiple other officers and medics arrived at the store. The aisle where the incident occurred was not in the camera's field-of-view.

This camera angle covered the front registers aisle inside the store. There was no embedded date/timestamp on the video. There was no audio stream associated with the video stream. It consisted of 13473 frames and was 00:14:58:191 long (hh:mm:ss:ms).

Amped Replay was used to generate bookmarked images as derivatives for this video file. The derivatives were for demonstrative purposes only. The frame numbers for the bookmarked images are detailed below:

Frame	726
Activity	Linderman's lower body, waist, and left hand/arm were in the camera's field-of-view. He appeared to be carrying a dark object in his left hand.

Frame	736
Activity	Linderman's lower body, waist, and left hand/arm were in the camera's field-of-view. He appeared to be carrying a dark object/item/package (possibly set of knives) in his left hand.

Frame	743
Activity	A person's right hand (likely Stopperich) grabbed the object/item/package from Linderman's left hand.

Frame	749
Activity	This is a better view of the item/package (likely the set of knives).

Linderman (partial view) moved out of the camera's field of view. Sometime later, multiple employees moved from the registers toward the aisles in the store (Linderman possibly attacking Stopperich in an aisle out of the camera's field-of-view). Employees also moved near the register and were looking at the aisles nearby.

Activity	Two officers moved near the front register aisle.

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Frame	7338
Activity	A shopping basket moved across the floor. The top of Linderman's head moved into the camera's field-of-view near the floor.

Frame	8524
Activity	Two additional uniformed officers entered the store.

Multiple other officers and medics arrived at the store. The aisle where the incident occurred was not in the camera's field-of-view.

The bookmarked images noted above were exported to the "Derivatives" folder and placed in the "Bkmrks - Registers Front" folder. The report was placed in the "Reports" folder.
