APPROVAL—CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE STATE OF OHIO AND P. L. FRANK FOR ALL BRANCHES OF TRADES EXCEPTING PLUMBING. SEWAGE AND GAS FITTING REQUIRED FOR THE OHIO STATE ARMORY STABLE AT RAVENNA, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval a contract by and between The P. L. Frank Construction Company of Ravenna, Ohio, and the State of Ohio, acting by Emil F. Marx, Adjutant General and Director of State Armories, for all branches of trades except plumbing, sewerage and gas fitting required for the Ohio State Armory Stable at Ravenna, Ohio, which contract calls for a total expenditure of nine thousand six hundred and fifty dollars (\$9,650.00).

You have also submitted the following papers: Encumbrance estimate No. 101, estimate of cost, division of contract, workmen's compensation certificate, letter from the Auditor of State stating that the necessary papers are on file in that office, the Controlling Board release, certificate of authority of the president of the contracting corporaton, affidavit of the personal responsibility of P. L. Frank, tabulation of bids, proof of publicaton, and form of proposal properly executed, with the bond in the amount of \$10,000, with P. L. Frank and H. R. Loomis as sureties and the justification, and the certificate of the Auditor of Portage County.

Finding said contract and bond in proper legal form, I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith to you, together with all other papers submitted in this connection.
