Narrative:

On July 5, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received records previously requested from the Youngstown Police Department (YPD). The records received included the body-worn camera (BWC) videos of the YPD officers that were on scene at [REDACTED] Youngstown, OH at the time of the officer-involved critical incident on June 13, 2024. This report will detail [REDACTED] s [REDACTED] BWC video.

Note that the video times referenced in this report will refer to the elapsed time of the video.

[REDACTED] s BWC video is 1 hour, 16 minutes, and 34 seconds in duration. The video begins showing [REDACTED] driving a vehicle. At 00:25, [REDACTED] exited the vehicle. No sound could be heard until 00:30.

At 01:24, [REDACTED] walked onto the porch of the residence and at 01:29, [REDACTED] knocked on the door. At 01:43, [REDACTED] again knocked on the door. At 02:05, a female voice could be heard saying "No, no, no, no. I'm opening the fucking door now. Fuck you, fuck you."

At 02:16, the door opens. See screenshot below taken at 02:18, showing [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) pointing toward the rear of the residence. At this time, she also says (unintelligible) "He has a gun, he got the gun on my mom in the other room."

At 02:21, [REDACTED] said "Fuck, down, down, down." [REDACTED] fired several shots beginning at 02:23. Gunfire stopped at 02:27. Trinidad said "Shit. What the fuck. What the fuck." Screaming and yelling could be heard. At 02:42, [REDACTED] began yelling to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] then walked out of the dark hallway area with her hands raised. See screenshot below taken at 02:46.

[REDACTED] then walked toward the dark hallway/ bedroom. [REDACTED] approached the bedroom door and then at 03:01, [REDACTED] said "He's still breathing, still breathing." At 03:06, [REDACTED] said "Get the gun, get the gun, get the gun, get the gun. I got him covered, I got him covered. Get the gun out of his fucking hand." At 03:08, Officer Tony Kaleugher (Kaleugher) shined his flashlight on Mathue O'Malley (O'Malley). A pistol could be seen in O'Malley's hand.

At 03:14, ██████ said "Fuck." ██████ kept O'Malley at gun point. A fire alarm could be heard as well as crying and yelling from ██████ and ██████

At 03:47, Officer Nico Rodriguez (Rodriguez) asked "What do we got?" ██████ replied, "I think I got, I think I got a headshot on him" [03:50]. Rodriguez asked if he (O'Malley) was still breathing. ██████ said that he stopped. Rodriguez and another officer then entered the room with a medical kit. At 04:33, ██████ radioed for a supervisor.

At 05:17, Rodriguez asked ██████ "You good?" ██████ replied "Yeah, I'm good, I'm good. My adrenaline is going a fucking million miles an hour but I'm good." At 06:48, ██████ exited the residence. At 07:00, ██████ said, "I think I unloaded a mag." ██████ walked to the driveway area and at 08:26, ██████'s BWC was muted.

At 11:38, an ambulance pulled onto the street in front of the residence. At 12:21, ██████ sat in a police vehicle. At 17:12, an EMS worker approached ██████ At 18:07, ██████ removed his external body armor with the BWC attached. At 18:40, the vest with BWC attached was placed in the floorboard area of a police vehicle. The BWC view was obscured. See example below taken at 18:45.
