ACTION TAKEN: On the morning of June 27th, Akron Police Officers were involved in a traffic stop, car chase, and use of deadly force. The incident started in the area of E. Tallmadge/Thayer and ended on E. Wilbeth near Main St. Initially, it was uncertain as to who was going to do the investigation. Eventually the decision was made that the Ohio Attorney General's Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) would do the investigation and that I would be the liaison with BCI. I was told to contact Mark Kohler of BCI and coordinate the investigation. Kohler told me that Cory Momchilov would be the lead investigator. I made contact with Momchilov. We agreed to meet that afternoon to discuss the case.

Sgt. Orrand from Midnight DB responded to the initial call and was at the Medical Examiner's office where Walker had been transported. I responded to the ME's office to discuss the case with Orrand and to get a preview of Walker's body. I inquired as to when the autopsy would be done to relay that information to BCI because they wanted to be present. While I was there, the ME was still in the process of examining the body and x-rays. I reported to Momchilov what I observed and that the autopsy was hours away, if not till the next day. Momchilov contacted the ME's officer to arrange an investigator be present during the autopsy.

I met with Momchilov to discuss the case. He gave my BCI's "Requesting BCI Investigative Services for an Officer-Involved Critical Incident." He explained the records his agency was going to need from Akron which are listed on page 8. After reviewing the list, I told him that I would immediately begin getting him the information. During are short meeting, Deputy Chief Harding and Captain Brewer came in and introduced themselves.

Early afternoon on the 27th, we realized that no one notified Walker's family. After conferring with BCI and the Medical Examiner's office, it was determined that Akron PD would make the family notification. We were able to find his mother's information (Pamela Walker, 827 Valdes). We also found a sister (Jada Walker) who possibly lived with her mother. Detective Bertina King and I responded to Valdes to make notification.

Upon arrival on Valdes we met with Pamela Walker, Jada was not present. King asked Pamela if Jayland was her son, which she confirmed. King asked her when

the last time was, she talked to him. She said she talked to him yesterday and that she was trying to reach him today, but he wasn't answering. She asked King if Jayland was okay. We could see the concern building in Pamela's demeanor. King explained to Pamela what happened. She told her that officers tried to stop Jayland who refused to stop. She went on to explain that a car chase ensued, and that Jayland fired a gun at officers. The chase ended in Firestone Park area where Jayland ran from the car and that the foot chase ended with officers shooting Jayland. She explained that we did not have many more details than that and that Akron Police were not investigating the incident and that BCI was doing it. Early in King's conversation, we could see the anxiety building in Pamela. Pamela asked if Jayland was okay. King explained to her that multiple shots were fired, and that Jayland was dead. Pamela broke down hysterically. Eventually she asked why Jayland did what he did and why did we shoot him. King reiterated that we did not have all the details and that we were not the investigators. Pamela cried hysterically for several minutes before we could ask her if there was someone, we could call for her. She called Jada who was working in Montrose. She had Jada on speaker and explained to her what happened to Jayland. Jada broke down and said she was on her way home. Pamela asked several times why Jayland did what we were telling her he did. She said that it didn't sound like Jayland's character. She said he didn't get in trouble and couldn't understand this behavior. We agreed that on face value it seems out of character.

During our conversation with Pamela, it came out that Jayland was engaged to Jaymeisha Beasley who was killed in a horrific car accident on May 28, 2022. Pamela told us that the family was concerned with Jayland's dealing with her death. She said he took it extremely hard and was still trying to get through it. I asked if he talked about being so depressed that he wanted to hurt himself. She said no. I asked if he was the type of person to talk to her about those type of feelings. Again, she said no. At some point, I whispered in King's ear wondering if this was a suicide by cop. Pamela was extremely upset. We asked her several times if there was someone, we could call for her. She told us that she would have to eventually tell her elderly mother, who she didn't think could handle the news. She also mentioned a male relative who lives in the Columbus area that she was going to eventually call. King offered to call for some pastoral care, which she eventually called and arranged. A pastor was enroute to the house.

Jada was driven to the house by a co-worker due to her being so upset. When Jada arrived, King went outside to greet her and talk to her. King explained to Jada in more detail as to what happened. While they were outside, Joe Fouche, Jr. arrived to talk to the family. Fouche gave his card in which he represented

ICM (Integrated Consulting & Management). They told him that the family did not want to talk to him and that it wasn't the right time to contact with family. Jada and King came inside to further comfort Pamela. Moments later, King and I went outside with Jada. Outside the conversation of Jayland's depression over Jaymeisha came up. Again, I asked her if Jayland talked about hurting himself and if he was the type of person to talk about that. Jada, like her mother said they were concerned about Jayland's wellbeing, and that he did not talk about hurting himself, but was not the type of person to talk about those type of feelings. While outside, Pastor Dejournett and a fellow pastor arrived. As they arrived, Jada called her uncle who lives in Columbus and broke the news to him.

Having the two pastors on scene and seeing that the family was in comforting hands, King and I cleared.

Tuesday, June 28, 2022. Standard protocol dictates that BCI's Crime Unit process the scene, which they did. Normally they hand over the evidence from that processing to our department, which they did after they completed processing. Later that day when the decision was made that BCI would conduct the investigation, I organized and prepared getting that evidence back to them. Along with Sgt. Mostar, we checked out the property from the Property Room and drafted a change of custody form for both parties to sign. Walker's vehicle was towed to APD's processing garage at 800 Dan Street. BCI obtained a search warrant to process that vehicle. I transported the case property to Dan Street to turn over to BCI. I met them at the processing garage, turned over the property and stood by while they processed Walker's vehicle. During the search, they recovered a wedding ring on the driver's seat and a cell phone from the center console.

I received a message from Cuyahoga Falls Officer Jarett Heatwall [REDACTED]. In following up with him, I learned that he was sitting on Tallmadge Avenue when the Akron Officers approached the expressway. As he sat at the light, he saw both vehicles get on the expressway and then heard at least one shot. He decided to join the chase. He called it out on his dispatch channel so there should be a record of his actions. I told him that I was going to pass this information on to BCI who was doing the investigation and to expect a phone call.

During the days following, I worked on getting the requested records that BCI requested. During those days, there was much discussion as to the officers' interviews as to who would conduct them and who would be present. After much discussion, it was determined that BCI would conduct the interviews. The Police Union assigned individual attorneys to each officer, so coordination with BCI,

I, Detective Aber #1398, was working Midnight Major Crimes on 6/27/22.



I responded to the scene of the officer involved shooting. When I first arrived on scene I spoke to patrol supervisors who stated that they had 8 officers who were involved and that the suspect was deceased. I relayed that information to Sgt. Orrand #1197, Detective Mike Willaims #1189 and Detective Keith Williams #1351.

I did a brief walk through of the parking lot where the shooting took place. I walked over to the vehicle that was crashed into the church. I used one of the officers flashlight and I looked inside the car. I observed a gun and a magazine sitting on the driver's seat. The magazine was not inside the gun but was sitting next to the gun.

I was tasked with asking the eight officers involved in the shooting three public safety questions.

1. Did they fire with a handgun or their rifle?
2. How many rounds they think they fired?
3. Did they use their taser?

While on scene, Michael Desantis (Supervisor for Bridgestone Security) arrived to see if we needed to look at the facilities cameras. I went to Michael's office and we looked through all of his cameras that might have caught the incident. The two cameras that would have captured the incident were not working at the

time. There was one camera that showed E. Wilbeth Rd. and you could see police lights in the distance. None of the cameras that we viewed that night captured the incident.

I was directed by Sgt. Orrand to respond, along with Detective Keith Williams and CSU detectives, to the southbound ramp at Rt. 8 and Tallmudge Ave. I was on the ramp when Det. D'Annunzio #1349 located a shell casing.

I responded back to the incident location while BCI processed the scene. I remained on scene until 0700.

As the scene was being opened, additional evidence was located by the east side of the building, Bridgestone Center for Research and Technology. Several spent bullets and fragments were found so BCI photographed and collected the items. These were also transferred to APD. Sgt. Miller and I returned to CSU where we both tagged the evidence into the Property Room.
