be such as may be agreed upon by and between said Board of Trustees and the City of Columbus.

Upon examining this agreement, which has already been executed by the City of Columbus, by William J. Lucks, its Director of Public Service, pursuant to the authority of a resolution of the Council of said city adopted March 19, 1934, I find said contract and the specifications of the sewer to be constructed thereunder to be in substantial conformity with the statutory authority above referred to, and that the conditions and covenants incorporated in and made a part of said contract are such as have reasonable and proper relation to the work to be done by the City of Columbus in the construction of this sewer and to the protection of the property and interests of the state during the course of such construction.

I am therefore approving this proposed agreement as to the form thereof, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon said agreement and upon the copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned to you.
