Narrative:

On Monday, October 20, 2025, at approximately 14:30 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents (SA) Ryan Emahiser (SA Emahiser) and SA Joseph Lamping (SA Lamping) attempted to interview Sarah Bailey (Sarah) at her residence on Oakfield North Road, relative to the officer-involved critical incident which took place on Sunday, October 12, 2025. Sarah is the wife of the subject involved, Brad Bailey (Brad). The purpose of the attempted interview was to obtain all relevant information leading to the incident known or observed by Sarah.

Sarah was not initially at the residence, and Agents' left contact information with a family member that was present to provide. Shortly after Agents left the residence, Sarah contacted SA Emahiser's cell phone. The phone call was not recorded, but Sarah did advise that she would be willing to speak with agents on a later date about Brad and the incident. Sarah had questions about her vehicle and getting access to her belongings in her vehicle, and SA Emahiser advised Sarah that the Trumbull County Prosecutor authorized the release of her 2012 Buick that is currently being held by the Warren Police Department (WPD). SA Emahiser also told Sarah that WPD had been notified that her vehicle could be released, and SA Emahiser provided Sarah with the contact person at WPD to get access to her vehicle.

SA Emahiser exchanged several texts with Sarah attempting to set up an interview, and on October 27, 2025, Sarah texted SA Emahiser that she preferred that all coordination for an interview go through her attorney Aaron Meikle. On that same date SA Emahiser called Attorney Meikle and left a voicemail requesting a call back to set up an interview with Sarah and also advised the purpose of the interview.

As of the date of this report no further contact has been received from Sarah or Attorney Meikle.
