On 10/7/2025 I was dispatched to 9132 US 62 regarding a stolen vehicle.

Upon arrival I met with the caller and victim, Larry Lockhart. Larry advised that at some point last night his truck was stolen from his property. The truck is a 1995 Ford F-800. Larry owns the building on the property and rents out parts of the building to different people. One of the individuals he rents to possibly has camera footage, but Larry will be able to check tomorrow and contact us. Larry said the truck has a new welder on it and he would be able to get me the serial number and other details about it tomorrow as well.

Behind the building on Larry's property, there was a black Chevy Tahoe pulled back into a wooded area. Larry said it was not his and did not know who it belonged to. The vehicle was not entered into LEADS as stolen, but whoever left it may have been the one who stole Mr. Lockhart's truck. After speaking with Captain Strawser, he wanted the vehicle to be towed to our impound lot.

The Ford F-800 was entered into LEADS. The NIC number is [REDACTED]

On 10/8/2025, I made contact with Larry Lockhart over the phone to get additional information regarding his stolen Ford F-800, black in color.

While speaking with Larry, I confirmed that his truck did not have the keys in it, but he did leave it unlocked and there was not a plate on it.

Larry made contact with the person who sold him the welder and he was still waiting on her to send him the serial number. At the time of our conversation, Larry was driving, so he was not able to give me the contact information for the individuals who have cameras on his property. He advised that he would call me back this afternoon or tomorrow, 10/9/2025.

Grove City PD located this stolen vehicle at 3810 Louise Court, Grove City, Ohio, 43123, on date- 10/8/25 at 1714 hrs. The suspect was located at the home with this vehicle and was then involved in an officer involved shooting, after which he was transported and pronounced deceased. Per GCPD, the vehicle has been taken to their Ventura facility located at 4444 Broadway, Grove City. Captain Strawser was contacted and is aware of the situation. Suspect Info given by GCPD is the registered owner of the vehicle left behind at the location of theft. Male info has been added to call.





AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF WARRANT TO SEARCH

The facts upon which such belief is based are as follows:

On October 8, 2025 at 5:15pm, Thomas Mclean called the Grove City Police to report an unknown male was inside his house at 3810 Louise Court, Grove City, Ohio 43123. Mclean said he saw the male at the top of the stairs when he opened the door. Grove City Police Officers arrived on the scene and confirmed with Mclean that no one was supposed to be inside his house. Police began giving commands for the male to exit the residence. The male yelled something to the officers about not seeing their badges. After a couple hours of refusing to exit the residence, Grove City Police deployed gas into the house. The suspect ran out of the house and Grove City Police Officers chased after the suspect on foot. During the chase, gunshots were fired and the suspect was shot. Grove City Police [REDACTED] was also shot. The suspect and [REDACTED] were transported to the hospital. The affiant is requesting the search warrant for 3810 Louise Court, Grove City, Ohio to recover evidence for the commission of the criminal offense of burglary.




