Narrative:

As part of the ongoing investigation of the Officer Involved Critical Incident that occurred on March 11, 2022, on I-71 near mile marker 123, BCI Special Agent Todd Fortner (SA Fortner) received and reviewed the personnel files of the Columbus Division of Police (CPD) officers involved. SA Fortner received the personnel files of CPD Officers Joseph Valiski (Ofc. Valiski), Nathan Komisarek (Ofc. Komisarek) and Aaron Getzinger (Ofc. Getzinger). The files contained training records, disciplinary records and firearms qualification records. SA Fortner also obtained the officers' certification records from the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA).

Upon review, SA Fortner found that all three officers had current OPOTA peace officer certification and were appointed to CPD. Their training records all appeared to be up to date and their firearms qualifications were current. All three officers qualified with their service pistol in January of 2022. Ofc. Komisarek and Ofc. Getzinger had qualified with their approved, personally owned patrol rifles in November 2021. SA Fortner found no substantiated complaint of the use of force in any of the officers' files.
