## Narrative:

On Monday, May 20, 2021, Bureau Of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Kevin Barbeau received the attached e-mail communication from Franklin County Children Services (FCCS) Legal Aide Supervisor Carolyn Gilroy. She communicated to SAS Barbeau that a portion of the records requested and received by BCI were unrelated to the original request. It should be noted records were requested and received prior to this date from FCCS (see referenced item) involving Ma'Khia Bryant, who was an involved subject during an Officer Involved Critical Incident.

The records were received on a CD and below was the material Gilroy noted should be ignored as they are unrelated to the Bryant file.

"It was an entry made on February 6, 2020. It can be found on disc 2, in the folder covering the time period of December 1, 2017 through October 16, 2020. It is on pages 3,877–3,881 of the file named "SACWIS AND ONBASE." That specific entry does not concern the Bryant matter."
