DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Works by Carl G. Wahl, Superintendent, and The Baker and Shindler Contracting Company of Defiance, Ohio, for the general contract for the Stadium, Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green, Ohio, which contract calls for a total expenditure of thirty-seven thousand five hundred and forty-one dollars (\$37,541.00).

You have also submitted other papers necessary in this connection. Attached to each contract is a certificate of the President of the Bowling Green State University certifying that funds are available for the payment of the Bowling Green State University's portion of the contracts for this Stadium, the remainder of the funds to be furnished from P.W. A., Docket No. OH-1389-D.

The certificate of publication of the notice to bidders, tabulation of bids received and the form of proposal of the lowest bidder, the certificate from the Industrial Commission of Ohio showing proper compliance of the lowest bidder with the laws of Ohio with regard to the workmen's compensation laws, the form of proposal properly executed, the bond of the New York Casualty Company, with the power of attorney of the signer, and the certificate of the Insurance Department showing that the surety is qualified to transact the business of fidelity and surety insurance in Ohio, are all found in order.

The letter of the State Architect and Engineer to the Board of Trustees of Bowling Green State University recommending the accept-

ance of the lowest bidder, the direction of the Department of Public Works to the State Architect and Engineer to enter into a contract for this work, and the final approval of this contract by the State Director of P.W.A. of Ohio, and the certificate of the Auditor of State that the necessary papers in connection with this contract are filed with the Auditor of State, are also submitted.
