I received a telephone call from Lieutenant (Lt.) D. Jesse of the Ohio State Highway Patrol's (OSHP) Cleveland/Warren District Office of Criminal Investigations (OCI) stating there was a Division officer involved shooting which occurred in Brookfield Township in Trumbull County. Lieutenant Jesse advised Trooper (Tpr.) Brian Depizzo of the (OSHP) Warren District (OCI) was on his way to the scene and or already on scene. I contacted Tpr. Depizzo in regards to the situation and a possible update. Tpr. Depizzo advised he was on scene, there were multiple agencies involved to include the Trumbull County Sheriff's Department and the Brookfield, Vienna, and Lordstown Police Departments. Tpr Depizzo further advised the scene was secured prior to his arrival and the address of the incident was 1433 State Route 7 Brookfield, Ohio. Tpr. Depizzo advised the Trumbull County Sheriff, Paul Monroe, was on scene, he had contacted the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations (BCI), and was currently the scene commander.

02:31 hours

I arrived at 1433 State Route 7 Brookfield, Ohio. The driveway to the actual scene location was approximately 2,640 feet long off the west side of State Route 7. The driveway was secured by officially marked Trumbull County Sheriff's Department and Brookfield Police Department cruisers. I was granted access to continue back to the incident location. Upon arrival to the actual incident location, I was greeted by Staff Lieutenant (S/Lt.) Brian Vail, Tpr. Depizzo, and Sergeant (Sgt.) Tim Grimm. Sgt. Grimm gave me a brief synopsis of the incident which occurred to include the involvement of the following Ohio State Highway Patrol Employees: Sgt. [REDACTED] Sgt. Grimm, Tpr. Scott Boyle, and Tpr. Kevin Brown. I was advised Sgt. [REDACTED] believed he fired approximately two (2) rounds. It was also learned there were multiple other agencies involved and additional officers who fired rounds during the incident. It was believed Sgt. Grimm, Tpr. Boyle, and Tpr. Brown did not fire any rounds.

The suspect was identified as [REDACTED] 149.43A1a who had multiple warrants for fleeing and eluding. I learned that earlier in the day, March 20th, [REDACTED] 149.43A1a led multiple law enforcement agencies on a pursuit through Trumbull County. The pursuit continued onto a railroad track in Brookfield Township, near the intersection of Albright McKay Road and Warren Sharon Road. [REDACTED] 149.43A1a traveled north on the railroad track in a vehicle and then fled on foot. Units from surrounding departments searched the area but were unable to locate [REDACTED] 149.43A1a at that time. Later that evening, or early the next morning, the property owner at 1433 SR 7, realized [REDACTED] 149.43A1a was on his property. Knowing [REDACTED] 149.43A1a was wanted, the property owner contacted Brookfield Police Department to inform them. Brookfield Police Department then contacted surrounding police agencies for assistance in apprehending [REDACTED] 149.43A1a given his propensity to flee from law enforcement. As a result of this request, troopers from the Warren Post responded to assist.

Now on scene, I surveyed the area and made the following observations: the area of the incident was wooded and had very little to no light. I could see yellow caution tape cordoning the scene off and Brookfield Police Detective, Aaron Kasiewicz, maintaining the Crime Scene Log. I observed a blue in color Chevrolet regular cab pickup with a steel snow plow on the front facing southeast on the gravel driveway. I could see multiple

Tpr. Depizzo photographed our units on scene showing the presence of our issued Ohio State Highway Patrol uniform utilized by our employees at the time of the incident. It was determined Tpr. Steve Tucci, Northeast Ohio Reconstruction team member, would be requested to assist in mapping the scene for BCI. It was determined all units involved would be relocated to an area away from the original incident. The OSHP units involved departed and then reconvened at the OSHP's Warren Post. Prior to leaving, I witnessed Tpr. Brown remove the previously secured weapons from the back seat and trunk area of his patrol car (SP3087), and place them into the rear of Tpr. Depizzo's unmarked patrol vehicle (SP1407). Tpr. Depizzo then locked the vehicle and retained the only access to the vehicle (remaining on scene).

03:38 hours

BCI Special Agent (S/A) Charles Moran (234-400-3618) arrived on scene. S/A Moran advised additional S/A's were on their way to assist in processing the scene and completing the investigation. BCI Senior Special Agent (S/A) Daniel Boerner (234-400-2618) arrived on scene.

04:02 hours

Senior S/A Boerner requested the weapons which were involved during the incident. Tpr. Depizzo unlocked SP1407 and all weapons were released to Senior S/A Boerner. Tpr. Depizzo then traveled to the OSHP Warren Post and completed a check of the 9mm handguns which were carried by the OSP Units involved with the incident. This was completed and documented on OSHP form 1254 (Semi-Auto Handgun Diagram) and a copy is included with this case report. This was completed as an investigative step to document whether the handguns had been fired during this incident. I stayed on scene as BCI completed their investigation and Tpr. Tucci assisted with mapping the scene.

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involved a subject connected to a manhunt which started earlier the same day.

I responded to the location, 1433 State Route 7 in Brookfield to assist as needed. I learned the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) would be the lead investigative agency in this matter.

Upon my arrival to the scene, I observed multiple law enforcement vehicles, both marked and unmarked, parked along the east side of the State Route 7 (SR7). I was immediately flagged to the driveway by Trooper (Tpr) Scott Boyle; I was unaware at that time if he was involved in the incident. Trooper Boyle escorted me to the actual shooting scene which was quite some distance off of SR7.

I was the first Ohio State Patrol investigator on scene and discovered all of the involved officers were still present - Brookfield Township Police, Vienna Township Police, Ohio State Patrol and Trumbull County Sheriff's Office.

A section of crime scene tape was placed across a single lane dirt/gravel driveway. The driveway led to a structure and a light blue in color Chevrolet CK 1500 pickup truck with a snow plow attached. This was the actual scene of the incident, which I did not enter. The officers involved in the incident from other agencies were still inside the crime scene. The State Patrol officers were outside of the scene, but close to the area. I took two quick photos of the scene from outside the crime scene tape.

I did speak quickly with Sergeants (Sgt) Timothy Grimm and [REDACTED] to gain a general idea as what occurred. I did not question them on the specifics about the incident. At this point, I discovered Tpr Kevin Brown, who was on scene and near the road when the officer involved shooting occurred, was in possession of all involved firearms.

Following my interaction with our troopers, I made contact with Detective Aaron Kasiewicz of the Brookfield Township Police Department and inquired about the presence of a crime scene log, as well as the estimated arrival time of the BCI.

Detective Kasiewicz advised BCI was at least an hour away for initial response and the crime scene units would be longer. Detective Kasiewicz did complete a crime scene log and was maintaining it for the duration of the incident or until relieved by BCI.

Following my discussion with Detective Kasiewicz, I made contact with our troopers and photographed them from two sides. This was done to document their appearance at the time of the incident. All three State Patrol troopers were wearing uniform of the day, which included their black soft shell jackets, extended cold weather toboggan and badges (the photos will be uploaded to the report).

By this point, Sgt Klingensmith arrived on scene, along with other Division personnel. After speaking with Sgt Klingensmith, it was determined we should collect the firearms in the possession of Tpr Brown and secure them in my state vehicle until BCI arrived on scene.

The weapons were all long guns which included:

I secured the weapons at approximately 0328 hours.

The weapons were subsequently turned over to BCI agents at 0402 hours.

I later was instructed by Sgt Klingensmith to clear from the scene and meet the troopers from the incident at the Warren Patrol Post and inspect their duty handguns. This was done not because it was suspected they fired their handguns, but as an investigative step to document the handguns had **NOT** been fired. All of the involved troopers were instructed to await BCI's arrival at the post.

At approximately 0545 hours, I met at the Warren Post with Sgt Grimm, Sgt [REDACTED], Tpr Boyle and Tpr Brown.

The following is a summary of results of involved trooper's handguns and back up weapons duty load. OHP form 1254 (Semi-Auto Handgun Diagram) was completed and will contain a complete documentation of the inspection.

All four troopers were carrying the Sig Sauer P-320 Carry version duty weapon.

Each Sig Sauer P-320 contained a full duty load of 52 rounds of 9mm ammo.

Three 17 round magazines and one round chambered.

All four troopers were carrying the Sig Sauer P-365 Subcompact duty weapon which is worn on their ankle.

Each Sig Sauer P-365 contained a full duty load of 11 rounds of 9mm ammo.

One 10 round magazine with one round chambered.

No officer was carrying a spare P-365 magazine.

Narrative Report

On 3/20/2023 at approximately 2339 hours, I, Ofc. Pishotti, was advised to call dispatch for assistance with Brookfield PD. Dispatched advised me that Brookfield PD had a location on a male subject, later identified as Fred Wild, who had been running from police and had stolen a vehicle in Brookfield Earlier in the afternoon. Brookfield was requesting assistance from Vienna Police to assist with the apprehension of the Wild.

I then got off the phone with dispatch and advised my supervisor, Sgt. Padula, of the situation so he was aware of the location of the officers assisting. Officer [REDACTED] and myself the proceeded to meet Brookfield units at a local mechanic shop on State Route 7 where we waited for other assisting units (TCSO, OSP, Vienna PD, Lordstown PD). Once all units arrived, Sgt. [REDACTED] from Brookfield PD advised all units of the address (1433 ST. Rt. 7) and gave a briefing of the plan and where the male was at on the property. Sgt. [REDACTED] was advised by the property owner earlier that there was a truck at his hunting cabin on his property that he did not recognized. the truck matched the description of the truck that was stolen earlier. Sgt. [REDACTED] stated the the cabin sat past tree line on the property about a quarter mile from the roadway. The plan was to approach the cabin, units surround the cabin, and call him out from the cabin to make the arrest. It was stated in earlier calls and CADs that the male was known to carry a muzzle loader as well.

After the brief, officers drove to the property at 1433 St. Rt. 7 and left the cars on the roadway. We made our approach on foot towards the cabin. As we made our approach on the tree line, we heard loud music coming from beyond the tree line. Once we got closer to the cabin, we were able to see the truck with a plow on the front of it that matched the description of the stolen vehicle from Brookfield PD. The truck was parked directly next to the cabin window and the loud music was coming from inside of the truck. A TCSO deputy moved towards the front of the cabin where he could see into the window and stated that he had eyes on the male and he was facing away from the window. As he advised me, I passed it along that we could see the male and we began surrounding the cabin.

Suddenly, the male stood up and looked out of the window and we began announcing our presence and for him to come out with his hands up. He did not listen and opened the window of the cabin and jumped into the front seat of the truck. The deputy ran up to the window of the truck along with Sgt. [REDACTED] and myself, and we were giving commands to get out of the truck. The male the started the truck and the deputy and I began using our rifle barrels to break open the passenger window on the truck. The male then slammed on the accelerator and was spinning his tires. Unable to open the window, we backed away from the truck still giving commands and

he gained traction of the tires and was going straight into the wood line heading towards other officers. At that moment, there were officers in imminent danger of being seriously injured or killed, I fired my service rifle at the male driving the truck.

After shots were fired, I got on the radio advised shots fired to dispatch and to let them know to contact Sgt. Padula. I then asked if all officers were okay and if anyone was hurt. Myself and the deputy cleared the cabin to make sure there were no others inside of the cabin. Officers then checked for a pulse on the male and called for a squad to come to the scene. I then got on the phone and called Chief Bob Ludt and advised him of the situation. BCI and Trumbull County Homicide Task Force were advised and en route to the scene. Scene was secured and weapons that were discharged were placed into the back of a OSP Cruiser. Once supervisors were on scene, I was removed from the scene. Cleared with no further incident.

On 3/20/2023 at approximately 2339 Hrs, I, Ofc [REDACTED] I called Ofc [REDACTED] in refence to him being requested to call dispatch, Ofc [REDACTED] informed that he would be assisting Brookfield Township Police with attempting to apperhend Fred Wild that they only requested one VTPD unit at this time. I had prior context to the situation as I already assisted BTPD with attempting to apperhend Fred Wild at his fathers residence in a trailer park off of St Rt 7 and that he was possibly armed with a muzzel loader fire arm. I called my supervisor Sergeant Padula for permission to also go assist BTPD for which he granted the request, Sergeant [REDACTED] of BTPD was fine with having a additional VTPD unit for assistance.

While at the staging ground at the mechanic shop on SR 7 I had to leave during the brief to respond to a alarm drop at Vienna Lawn & Garden. Upon shortly me returning all units (BTPD, LTPD, TCSO, OSP, VTPD) began the approach to 1433 SR 7. Once we arrived we exited our cruisers a gathered up to began the walk to down the drive way to the hunting cabin, I had left to turn on my flashers on my cruiser as I was the last parked cruiser. I asked OSP Trooper Brown and the TCSO Sergeant where the rest of the group had gone they informed they already going down the drive way on foot. They further informed me that they would be staying behind with the cruisers until Fred Wild was apphended or located and that then they would drive down the drive way.

Before reaching the units on foot I had noticed I had forgotten to turn on my body camera. Due to the audible activation sound of the body camera and that units where in state of noise and light displince to not alert the suspect I made the decsion to not activate it. Once I caught up with the other units on foot we approached the cabin and a truck equipped with a snow plow. The truck was parked very close on the south side of the cabin and was also playing music. At this point we seperated into two elements, one elemnet approached from the south side towards the truck, I went with the element going to the east side of the cabin in a wood line primarily composed of OSP troopers. During our approach the suspect became alerted of our prescence and the element near the truck rushed to the truck began loudly ordering the suspect to show his hands. The suspect did not comply and the officers surronding the truck began hitting the passenger side windows using the barrels of they're patrol rifles to attempt to gain entry to the truck. During this suspect had began to frantically attempted to ecscape spinning the wheels of the truck in the process I procedded to take steps back to avoid the path of the truck. The suspect gunned the truck forwards with no regard to the officers surronding and front of the truck during this I observed a OSP trooper approximately 30 feet in front of me just narrowly avoided the path of the trucks snow plow. Soon after I heard a series of gun shots near the truck and me. The truck headed towards the drive way at the moment I made the decision to fire my service rifle based on the suspect's wanton disregard of officers lives nearly hitting officers with a truck equipped with snow plow, the immediate danger of officers that where planned to head from SR 7,
