On December 26, 2024, as part of an ongoing officer involved critical incident investigation, Special Agent (SA) Brittney VanBibber retrieved evidence from the autopsy of Alex Russell from the Franklin County Coroner's Office (FCCO) located at the above address. At approximately 1253 hours, SA VanBibber received a bag containing numerous individually packaged items from Alexandra Fultz.

Once at the London BCI office, the evidence was generally photographed, and itemized as follows:

- Item 1: Ink print cards, FTA card, fingernail scraping kit
- Item 2: Projectile fragment from back of head
- Item 3: Projectile from lateral right upper chest
- Item 4: Projectile from right lower lobe lung
- Item 5: Projectile fragments from superior occipital bone
- Item 6: Projectile fragments from left occipital bone
- Item 7: Projectile fragments from optic chiasm/brain
- Item 8: Projectile from mid lateral left back
- Item 9: Projectile from upper left back
- Item 10: Jacket fragment from sphenoid sinus
- Item 11: Projectile from lower back midline
- Item 12: Projectile from left thigh
- Item 13: Projectile fragments from right paracervical
- Item 14: Projectile fragment from right paracervical tissue
- Item 15: Projectile fragments from right parotid gland
- Item 16: Projectile from under head
- Item 17: Autopsy photographs

SA VanBibber submitted Items 2-16 to London Evidence Receiving at approximately 1627 hours. Items 1 and 17 were deposited into London Temporary Locker #1 at 1653 hours.
