### Narrative:

On Thursday, June 27, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Eric Lehnhart (Lehnhart) received the following items related to the June 18, 2024, officer-involved shooting in Wadsworth, Ohio:

- Audio recorded 911 call and transcription
- Wadsworth Police Department (WPD) Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) reports
- Mobile Data Terminal (MDT) records

The documents and recordings were provided by WPD Chief Daniel Chafin. The recorded 911 call has been stored in the BCI SIU case file as Reference Item O. Both CAD reports and the MDT records have been uploaded to Matrix and attached to this report.

On Wednesday, July 3, 2024, WPD Dispatch Supervisor Kathryn Cindia provided SA Fletcher with the Radio Traffic and associated data. The radio traffic has been stored in the BCI SIU case file as Reference Item N.

On July 3, 2024, SA Fletcher reviewed the provided files and recordings and noted the following:

### Wadsworth Police Department CAD Reports

The WPD provided two CAD reports. One for the police department, and one for the fire department. The reports documented the times and personnel assigned to the calls.

The police department CAD Report was identified as "Call ID" [REDACTED]. The date of the call was 06/18/24, and the time entered was 21:02:34 hours. The call type was listed as "Report", and the location was 223 Durling Drive. The caller was listed as Stacy Sloane [incorrect spelling], phone number [REDACTED]. The CAD Report has been attached to this report for additional details.

The fire department CAD Report was identified as "Call ID" [REDACTED]. The date of the call was 06/18/24 and the time was 21:09:33 hours. The call type was Shooting (EMS) and the location was 223 Durling Drive. The CAD Report has been attached to this report for additional details.

Audio Recorded Dispatch and 911 Call and Transcription

There was one recording of the 911 call and a transcript. The recording was 6 minutes and 47 seconds long and titled:

- 7\_9\_1\_1\_Dispatch\_1\_2024\_06\_18\_21\_01\_12\_by\_Source\_Name\_asc.

The recording has been stored in the BCI SIU Case File and listed as Reference Item N.

A female dispatcher is heard answering the call stating "911, where is your emergency?". The female caller, who was later identified as Stacy Sloan (Stacy), stated "223 Durling Drive". The female dispatcher asked, "what is going on", to which Stacy replied, "my husband has a gun to his chest, and he is going to shoot himself" (00:06). Stacy repeated that her husband, Shannon Sloan (Shannon), was in the backyard of their residence with the gun to his chest. When the female dispatcher requested Stacy to hold, Stacy could be heard telling someone in the background "don't go back there...his gun is loaded" (00:40).

Stacy said she was currently at her neighbor's residence (213 Durling Dr.) and could not see Shannon. She stated Shannon was the only person at their residence (223 Durling Dr.). Stacy described the firearm as a handgun and said, "it could put a deer down" (01:40).

Stacy said this was not the first time Shannon had made a threat to shoot himself with a gun. Stacy indicated Shannon had been drinking and that he drinks every day. Prior to the 911 call, Stacy told the dispatcher she had an argument with her 18-year-old son in the driveway about a vape pen. Shannon intervened and began yelling. She told Shannon she was tired of the behavior between himself and her son.

During the 911 call, Stacy informed dispatch Shannon was no longer outside and that he went inside the home. Shortly after, she advised dispatch that he had returned outside and was now sitting in a chair in the backyard. Stacy said Shannon was located very close to the residence, and he had a holster on.

Stacy then became emotional and asked the dispatcher for the police not to shoot her husband. The dispatcher advised Stacy that the officers were on scene and would like to speak with her. The call then ends.

Audio Recorded Police Radio Traffic

There was one copy of the recorded radio traffic that included 36 radio transmissions. Transmissions came from the "Police Main" channel, and each transmission was stored in a separate WAV file, each titled with the date. Two text documents were also provided with the recordings. These documents contained identifying data for each of the recorded radio transmissions. After review, it was determined the documents contained the same information in different formats. Only one of the documents was reviewed for this report. Titled 2-CDR (Text Document).

SA Fletcher reviewed each of the recorded radio transmissions and the associated data. The table below contains the radio data and content of the radio traffic for the transmissions believed to be most relevant to the actual shooting incident. Multiple transmissions have more than one officer and/or dispatcher speaking. When necessary, the time stamp for the relevant portion of the recorded transmission was included. Original data received only listed the Radio ID of the first officer to initiate radio traffic in each transmission. Further data was requested and received for Radio IDs of all units involved.

The transmissions not included in the table above contained radio traffic from other responding officers and supervisors. The content of those radio transmissions included information related to responding back-up officers and the management of the critical incident after the shooting occurred.

MDT Records

SA Fletcher reviewed the MDT chat log from June 18, 2024. The records indicate one officer sent a group chat to seven officers prior to the incident. Two other officers exchanged five messages in total prior to the incident. All messages were unrelated to the shooting incident.

After the incident, one uninvolved officer exchanged two chats with another uninvolved officer. A group chat was sent by an uninvolved officer to all users logged into the system. The last entry was a message exchanged between two uninvolved officers. The content of all messages listed are unrelated to the incident at 223 Durling Drive.
