ASSIGNMENT:

On Thursday June 2, 2022, while on duty, I received the following text message from the Cleveland Police Communication Control Section; "FULL UDFIT @ 4562 W. 174th Street St, CMHA involved in shooting---31 year old male gsw to left lung and left hip. CMHA officer sustained minor injuries. CAD 259310."

At this time I contacted the Cleveland Police Communication Control Section and conferred with Chief Dispatcher and acknowledged receipt of the aforementioned text message and advised that I was responding. I then conferred with Sgt. Reese after which I proceeded to the scene and commenced with the following investigation.

EVIDENCE:

The following evidence was photographed and collected from the crime scene located at southwest corner just north of 4624 West 174th Street;

Marker # 1: Suspected Blood in the driveway near the south curb. This item measured to be 2' north of the south curb and 12' west of the stop sign. This item was placed in the **Homicide Unit Property Book Page 35, Line 20.**

Marker # 2: Black Stream light Stinger Flash Light were recovered in the grass along the south curb of the driveway to the west of the stop sign. 
Marker # 6 & # 7 were handled by Det. Borden # 43.

SCENE:

The location of occurrence for this incident is in the grass along at the south west corner of the driveway on the west side of West 174th Street in between 4562-4568 and 4622-4628 W. 174th Street. 4562-4568 is a four unit apartment building at the northwest corner of the driveway on West 174th Street. 4622-4628 is a four unit apartment building at the southwest corner of the driveway on West 174th Street. There is a stop sign at the southwest corner of the driveway at West 174th Street.

CMHA PD Zone Car 104 was parked at the southwest corner of West 174th and the driveway in between 4622-4628 and 4562-4568 West 174th Street. The zone car was parked along the west curb facing to the south.

We recovered the following evidence at the southwest corner of the driveway on West 174th Street which is just north of 4622-4628 West 174th Street; Suspected blood (Marker # 1) in the driveway along the south curb to the west of the stop sign.

Flashlight (Marker # 2), Pair of ASP Handcuffs (Marker # 3), Handcuff Key (Marker # 4), Tazer Wire (Marker # 5) and two Spent 9mm Cartridge Casings (Marker # 15 & 16) were recovered in the grass to the west of the stop sign.

The suspect MAALIK ROQUEMORE lived at 4624 West 174th Street which is in the apartment building at the south west corner just south of the driveway. The front entrance to apartment 4624 faces to the east.

We recovered the following evidence on the front step and on the front sidewalk of the front entrance to 4624 West 174th Street; Hennessy Cognac Bottle (Marker # 8) on the front sidewalk. Swisher Sweet Package (Marker # 9), Newport Cigarette Box (Marker # 10) and Orange Bic Lighter (Marker # 11) on front step.
