On February 28, 2024, as part of an ongoing officer involved critical incident investigation, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Crime Scene Technician (CST) Amy Gill retrieved evidence from the Franklin County Coroner's Office (FCCO).

At 1133 hours, CST Gill met with FCCO front desk attendant Sophia Vance and received a brown bag containing evidence from the autopsy of Colin Jennings. CST Gill returned to the BCI Main Office, located in London, Ohio, where the evidence was packaged and labeled as the following:

Item #	Description
1	Three projectiles recovered during autopsy
2	FTA Card from Colin Jennings
3	Fingernail scraping collection kit- collected from Colin Jennings
4	Bags from hands- collected during autopsy
5	CD containing photos taken during autopsy

At 1317 hours, CST Gill submitted item 1 (projectiles) to the BCI laboratory. The remaining items were placed into the BCI Temporary Evidence Locker #2 to be submitted to the BCI Major Crimes evidence vault.
