Narrative:

On Friday, October 13, 2023, at approximately 1050 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) interviewed Jen Schrenckengost (Schrenckengost). Schrenckengost is an Emergency Medical Technician employed by Emergency Medical Transport and responded to the officer-involved critical incident at 4312 Helena Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio, on October 12, 2023.

This report only summarizes the information deemed by the author to be of the most relevance to the investigation and does not purport to contain all questions and answers from the interview. Further, this report was placed in a chronology to aid the reader's overall understanding of the information obtained during the interview and may not be reflective of the actual sequencing of questions nor is it a word for word translation of either the questions or answers. It is suggested that the full recording be reviewed to clarify any content or contextual questions regarding the information from the interview.

The interview began with Schrenckengost stating that she was dispatched to Helena Avenue and was told to stage a short distance away from the scene at 4312 Helena Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio. After a few minutes, she was called to the aforementioned scene by the Youngstown Police Department officers at the scene.

Upon arrival, she was told by the officers to bring "everything" in regards to equipment. Schrenckengost then entered the residence and went to the patient (Ricco Acevedo) and began treatment.

After a short period of time, she began CPR on Acevedo which she continued for approximately twenty (20) minutes. Schrenckengost's supervisor, Jeff Dobson (Dobson), had responded to the scene to assist and he called Trumbull Memorial Hospital and spoke with a doctor. The doctor was given a briefing on the treatment Acevedo received and his current condition and the doctor told them to stop treatment.

SA Tingley asked what wounds she observed on Acevedo. Schrenckengost advised that she observed a wound on Acevedo's left flank near the armpit.

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The interview was then concluded at approximately 1053 hours.
