You have submitted a written petition, signed by one hundred qualified electors of this state, proposing the adopting of a constitutional amendment to be known as Section II of Article XV of the Constitution of the State of Ohio, together with a summary of the same.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 3519.01, Revised Code, it is the duty of the Attorney General to examine each constitutional amendment so proposed and the summary thereof, and if he finds such summary to be a fair and truthful statement of the proposed amendment, he shall so certify. I, therefore, confine my consideration to the above statutory requirements and hereby certify that such summary is a fair and truthful statement of the proposed constitutional provision. I do not, however, express any opinion as to the policy or wisdom of such proposed constitutional provision. The following certification is submitted for the uses provided by law:
