APPROVAL—LEASE OF OFFICE SPACE FOR USE BY THE DIVISION OF AID FOR THE AGED, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE IN MT. VERNON, OHIO—ALICE AND EDITH CURTIS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a certain lease executed by Alice and Edith Curtis of Mt.
