

observed the male's hand go behind him, he stepped back and tried to look through the rear window with his flashlight to see what his right arm was doing. was not able to see what his hands were doing.	k
After an OSHP trooper went onto the passenger side of the truck, stated he was able to see the male's arm fidgeting. demonstrated to by showing his right arm reaching towards the right rear of his buttocks. was not able to see his hands, but observed the male's arm fidgeting as if I was attempting to reach for something. At this point, stated that he not have his firearm out yet and that he was still trying to communicate with the m driver. At this point, stated when the OSHP trooper on the passenge side of the truck observed the gun in the male's hand, he then stepped back and dhis duty weapon. At this point, stated he was still close to the truck stated, "I still could not see his hand, um, when I started to step back that's when I seen his arm, his right arm coming up and with him confirming that had the firearm in his hand and the trooper standing at the driver side, I was in feet that he was going to end up shooting one of them and then that's when I did fire m service weapon at him as I was trying to retreat back with not knowing where every was at." stated after everyone went back towards cover, they reassessed the situation and began to move up towards the truck. As they approached the truck, stated, "he did still have the handgun in his right hand." (16:20 mai video 2 of 2). After they approached the male inside the truck, stated they yelled for the male to, "not to move the gun, not to move the gun." (16:29 mar video 2 of 2). Shortly thereafter, re-holstered and assisted another deputy by pulling the male out of the truck. After the male was removed from the truck, stated he removed the male's shirt to assess his wounds until EMS walked up to assist.	rk ed k of
When SA Goudy asked if the male made any comments related to he having a firearm; stated, "I did ask the trooper if he had any fire" they asked if he had any firearms, um, and the trooper told me that his response we you guys are safe. Odd response, yes." (23:04 mark of video 2 of 2). Stated he could not recall the male's response when he asked if there were any weapons inside the vehicle early on. If also stated that he does not resif the male fired his handgun. Just before the male was secured, another TCSO department of the handgun from the male's hand and rendered it safe by separating the from the male. If stated that he believed it was Deputy Fender who removed the gun from the male.	if vas • call uty
