### Narrative:

On Monday, December 30, 2024, at approximately 1030 hours, Crime Scene Technician Michael Rostocil removed previously secured evidence from the drying cabinet and packaged them for permanent storage. Item #5.1 - piece of Jeans, bloodstained and Item #5.2 - piece of black American Eagle pants, bloodstained, were removed from the drying cabinet located at 4055 Highlander Parkway, Richfield, OH 44286 (BCI Richfield Office), packaged in paper bags and sealed. The items were given to Administrative Professional II Betty Farris to enter into Matrix and place into permanent storage.
