The abstract as submitted was prepared and certified under date of November 29, 1926, and pertains to the following described premises, to wit:

Being Lots Nos. 829, 830 and 831 in Hudson's Addition to the city of Athens as shown on the recorded plat of said addition, Vol. 3, page 51 of the Records of Plats in the office of the recorder of said county.
