APPROVAL—CONTRACT FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH ADDITION TO AUDITORIUM AT BOWLING GREEN STATE COLLEGE, BOWLING GREEN, OHIO — THOMAS D. McGLAUGHLIN AND ASSOCIATES, LIMA, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by and through the Department of Public Works, for and on behalf of the Board of Trustees of Bowling Green State College, Bowling Green, Ohio, and Thomas D.
