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APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASE TO LAND IN COVENTRY TOWNSHIP, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO—ALMA F. SENDERLING, AKRON, OHIO.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, August 24, 1936.

Hon. Earl E. Hanefeld, Director. Department of Agriculture. Columbus, Ohio.

DEAR SIR: I am in receipt of a communication from the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in vour department, requestiong my approval of a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Alma F. Senderling of Akron. Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen (15) years, and which provides for an annual rental of \$6.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for walkway and docklanding purposes only, that portion of the State reservoir property along East Reservoir, Portage Lakes, that lies in front of lots numbers 28 and 29, of the East Reservoir Allotment as recorded in Plat Book No. 11. Page 8, Summit County Records, and being a part of Tract No. 13, Coventry Township, Summit County, Ohio, said lot having a frontage of fifty (50) feet.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restriction therein contained, that the same are in conformity with section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned
