On February 15, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Kevin Wanger was assigned to assist the Monroe Police Department with an ongoing officer involved critical incident. On February 12th, 2022 the Monroe Police Department (MPD) was involved in a shooting that killed Dustin Booth (see report: Processing of State Route 63 and New Garver Road - Scene #1).

On February 15th, 2022, at 0800 hours, SA Wagner retrieved items of evidence from the Hamilton County Coroner's Office in regards to Dustin Booth's autopsy. The following items were collected:

At 1122 hours, SA Wagner submitted items 2-9 to the BCI laboratory for examination. Item 1 will be submitted into the BCI major crimes evidence locker.
