On Tuesday, June 22, 2021, Special Agent (SA) Jared Prill (Prill) met with Chief Edward Tomba of the Middleburg Heights Police Department. During this meeting, SA Prill was provided access to Sergeant (Sgt.) [REDACTED] s ([REDACTED] personnel file and was able to make copies of the provided information.

A review of the information identified Sgt. [REDACTED] as having a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice and that he attended The Ohio Peace Officer Basic Training Program (the basic police academy) at the University of Akron in 2008.

Upon completion of the basic police academy, Sgt. [REDACTED] was hired as a police officer with the Marlboro Township Police Department in Stark County, Ohio. Sgt. [REDACTED] worked at this agency from May 2009 through June 2010, when he was hired by the Middleburg Heights Police Department; where he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant in January 2021 and continues to serve in that capacity.

Since completing the basic police academy, Sgt. [REDACTED] has attended over 500 hours of advance training courses and seminars; the majority of which are directly related to the routine tasks and operations conducted by law enforcement officers. Specifically noted was training related to crisis intervention and dealing with mental illness, first line supervision training and certification as a field training officer.

Apart from his role at the Middleburg Heights Police Department, Sgt. [REDACTED] is assigned to the Southeast Enforcement Bureau's (SEB) SWAT Team. Sgt. [REDACTED] has received specialized training as part of this assignment that includes a 40 basic SWAT school put on by the Ohio Tactical Officers Association in 2018.

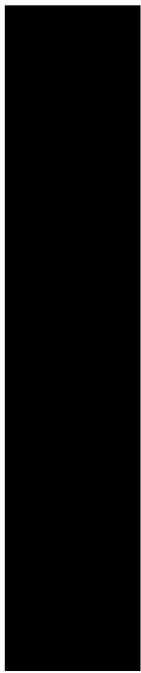
As part of his assignment to the SEB West SWAT team, Sgt. [REDACTED] participates in regular bi-monthly trainings. This training focuses on specialized tasks performed by the SWAT team and includes: additional firearms and range training, entry training, building clearing, less lethal and distraction techniques, perimeter security and active shooter response.

Noted in Sgt. [REDACTED] s file were numerous accolades and letters of praise from the community for the professionalism demonstrated by Sgt. [REDACTED] during his calls of service.

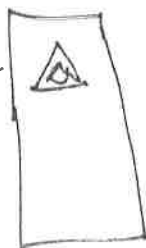
