NAGEL, SOUTH AKRON, OHIO, TERM FIFTEEN YEARS, ANNUAL RENTAL, \$6.00, DESCRIBED RESERVOIR PROPERTY, FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, RIGHT TO OCCUPY AND USE FOR BOAT HOUSE, DOCKLANDING AND LAWN PURPOSES.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the State of Ohio through you as Conservation Commissioner to Charles H. Nagel of South Akron, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$6.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for boathouse, dock-landing and lawn purposes, that portion of the State reservoir property along West Reservoir, that is included in the waterfront and State land in the rear thereof adjacent to Lot No. 31, Catalpa Grove Allotment No. 2, as recorded on page 79, Volume 21 of the plats on record in Summit County; said lot having a frontage of fifty feet, and being a part of Section 1, Franklin Township, Summit County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
