Narrative:

On 06/29/2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Tiffany Vollmer (Vollmer) interviewed Firefighter Ryan Young (Young) of the Lima Fire Department (LFD), relative to the officer-involved shooting which took place on 06/21/2022. The interview took place at Lima Central Fire 433 S. Main Street, Lima, Ohio. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual regarding their response to the incident scene. The following is a summary of the interview which was recorded and attached to the case file:

Young, who is a paramedic, has 19 years at LFD. When the call for service went out, Young remembered hearing it was an officer-involved shooting with the officer being hit. Young said he was the medic in charge of the unit. When he arrived, he saw flashing lights at the scene. He was instructed by Lieutenant Kavalauskas to begin patient care, such as IVs (intravenous therapy) and blood draws, at the ambulance. The deputy was already bandaged so Young didn't see his injury. The deputy was eventually transported to Lima Memorial Hospital.

When Young approached the scene, a state trooper was flashing his flashlight; Young saw what he thought was the subject lying in the grass at the scene, but he did not approach the body.
