TWO LEASES — STATE PUBLIC ARCHERY HUNTING GROUNDS, TO STATE FROM MARY CUNDIFF, 2448—J. C. BRUNDIGE 2449—DESIGNATED LAND, MARLBOROUGH TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval two leases Nos. 2448 and 2449. Lease No. 2448 is executed by Mary Cundiff of Delaware, Ohio, to the State of Ohio on a parcel of land in Marlborough Township, Delaware County, Ohio, containing 50 acres of land, as described in said lease. Lease No. 2449 is executed by J. C. Brundige of Delaware, Ohio, to the State of Ohio on a parcel of land in Marlborough Township, Delaware County, Ohio, containing 248 acres of land, as described in said lease. By these leases, which are each for a term of one (1) year, these lands are leased and demised to the state for the sole purpose of a state public archery hunting ground.

Upon examination of these leases, I find that the same have been executed and acknowledged by the lessors in the manner provided by law. I also find upon examination of the provisions of these leases and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with the statutory provisions relating to the execution of a lease of this kind.

I am accordingly approving these leases as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the same and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
