Narrative:

On Monday, November 24, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb (SA Holcomb) compiled background information on Christopher Lindner (Lindner), a subject involved in the incident on November 14, 2025. The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records, court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries, and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit and the Indian Hills Police Department.

SA Holcomb reviewed the information and noted the following:

Prior Police Encounters:

- December 27, 2019
 - Indian Hills Police Department responded to a domestic dispute involving Lindner and his wife, Tabitha.
 - An aggravated menacing charge was later filed; charge was later dropped.

Supplement Title: INVESTIGATIVE NOTES - AGGRAVATED MENACING

On 12/27/19 at 1158 hrs, I responded to 9350 Whitegate, the Lindner residence, for a reported domestic dispute. Upon arrival, I met with Ms. Tabitha Lindner and her children at the end of the driveway who reported that her husband, Christopher D. Lindner, was heavily intoxicated and armed with a handgun. She stated that Christopher had just attempted to come home after drinking all night with his brother. Tabitha Lindner further noted that on the previous evening, she had locked herself with her children inside her bedroom as Christopher had been dillusional. She stated that he had told her to be quiet as there were people in the yard to kill them . On date of report, Christopher approached the back door of the house with a handgun in his hand. She told Christopher that she was not going to let him in and if he persisted that she would push their panic alarm button. Tabitha Lindner took pictures of Christopher as he manipulated and pointed a handgun at her through the house's glass door. Christopher eventually gained access to the house with his key and, according to victim statement, continued to insult and name call the complainant. Due to the panic button NOT working, Tabitha called her father-in-law who in turn called estate property manager, Todd McFarland, who then contacted the Indian Hill Police Department.

Tabitha Lindner provided a written statement at the scene as Officer Jacob and I held our position at the street. She was then asked to respond to the Indian Hill Police Station where Dispatcher Milliron was awaiting her arrival. I spoke with Christopher's father, Carl Lindner III, via public service. Mr. Lindner had been trying unsuccessfully to convince his son to leave his house unarmed and walk down the driveway as we had requested. Officer Jacob had also spoken with Christopher via public service with no success. Contact was made with command staff and Captain Dressell and Chief Schlie soon arrived. Concessions were negotiated and Mr. Lindner agreed to step from his house and speak with Chief Schlie and family confidante, Jim Burdick. Mr. Lindner was allowed to leave the property with Mr. Burdick pending charges of aggravated menacing. Tabitha Lindner provided permission for the Indian Hill Police Department to enter her home and remove the firearms. Tabitha Lindner was in contact with her father- in- law and agreed to respond with her children to her parent's home in Burlington Kentucky. Christopher was then driven to another family owned home. Officer Bird escorted Tabitha back to the family home so that she could recover a few items before departing for her parents home. Officer Jacob responded to the Hamilton County Clerk's Office and filed a single charge of aggravated menacing. Dispatcher Milliron entered the warrant and attached Christopher's vehicles. His arrest or voluntary surrender is pending.
