DISAPPROVAL, FINAL RESOLUTIONS FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, VINTON COUNTY, OHIO.

DEAR SIR:—I am returning, enclosed, without my approval, the two following final resolutions sent me with your letter of March 24, 1921:

McArthur-Gallipolis road, I. C. H. 398, Section "C," Vinton county.

Chillicothe-McArthur road, I. C. H. No. 365, Section "L," Vinton county.

In the case of the first noted of these final resolutions, the county auditor's certificate bears date March 22, 1921, whereas the final resolution itself as shown by the certificate of the clerk of the board of county commissioners appears to have been adopted on the 21st day of February, 1921.

In the case of the second noted final resolution, the auditor's certificate bears date March 22, 1921, whereas the final resolution itself as shown by the certificate of the clerk of the board of county commissioners appears to have been adopted on February 19, 1921.

By reason of the provisions of sections 1218 and 5660 G. C., the final resolution of the county commissioners should not be adopted until at or after the time of the making of the auditor's certificate.
