Narrative:

On Monday, June 3, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) received an email from Cathy Clarke of the Tuscarawas County Coroner's Office. The email correspondence consisted of the autopsy report for Matthew Flynn (Flynn) conducted by the Cuyahoga County Coroner's Office (CCCO), the Toxicology Report from the Cuyahoga County Regional Forensic Science Laboratory and the Case Summary report from the Tuscarawas County Coroner's Office.

The information deemed to be the most relevant to this investigation is summarized below for the convenience of the reader. However, as the author is not a doctor, it is suggested that the report be viewed in its entirety to ensure no pertinent information has been omitted or described out of context.

SA Tingley reviewed the aforementioned documentation and noted the following:

The CCCO Autopsy Report was authored by Daniel Sullivan, M.D.

The autopsy was performed by Daniel Sullivan, M.D. on April 1, 2024, at 0900 hours at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office.

The "Cause of Death" for Flynn was listed as '

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The "TOXICOLOGY LABORATORY FINAL REPORT" noted that the Cuyahoga County Regional Forensic Science Laboratory reported on April 3, 2024 the following information:



EVIDENCE COLLECTED

- 1. One adhesive stub for gunshot primer residue examination from the hands
- 2. One swab from under the fingernails of the right hand
- 3. One swab from under the fingernails of the left hand
- 4. Blood stain card
- 6. Buccal swabs from release
- 7. Projectile from left chest

There was also a note on the form which stated that items 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 were packaged as BCI item 23 and submitted to BCI main evidence, Betsy Farris on 4/10/2024 @1320 hrs. Item 7 was packaged as BCI item 24 and placed in BCI Richfield Temporary locker #3 on 4/10/2024 @1324 hrs.
