APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASE FOR THE RIGHT TO  
OCCUPY AND USE FOR DOCKLANDING PURPOSES ONLY—  
O. H. GREENHO, AKRON, OHIO.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a communication over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your Department, requesting my approval of a reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one O. H. Greenho of Akron, Ohio. By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of six dollars, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for docklanding purposes only, that portion of Portage Lakes property which consists of the waterfront and state land in the rear thereof that lies along the southerly end of Koontz Lake, beginning at a point that is 640 feet south of the line which was originally the northerly farm line of said lessee and extending thence in a southwesterly direction 40 feet to a point; said land being in the east half of the northwest quarter of section 7, Green Township, Summit County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by O. H. Greenho, the lessee therein named. I also find, upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained that the same are in conformity with section 471 and other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind. I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
