grant relief in the form of canned goods to indigent persons there is included the implied power to label such canned goods in such a manner as to retain the title to such canned goods in the State of Ohio until the container has been opened for the purpose of consumption of the contents by the indigents and to forbid the sale or barter of the same by any person. Such implied power necessarily flows from the express power given to distribute poor relief to indigents in order that the State Relief Commission may be assured that the indigent persons and not others are the recipients of poor relief.

Consequently, in specific answer to your inquiry, it is my opinion that the State Relief Commission has the power to label canned goods to be distributed to indigent persons in such a manner as to retain the title to such canned goods in the State of Ohio until the container has been opened for the purpose of consumption of the contents by such indigents and to forbid the sale or barter of the same by any person.
