### NARRATIVE SUPPLEMENT

On 9/6/2023 at approximately 2138 hours, Officers were dispatched to 32801 Lorain Rd., Super 8 Motel for a male who was unresponsive.

Upon arrival, I observed Ptlm. Mobley at the entrance of the hotel, with a group of people standing around. I observed Ptlm. Mobley attempting to get a male later identified as, Robert Harmon Jr., out of wheelchair. I assisted Ptlm. Mobley and helped place Robert on the ground. Once Robert was on the ground, I performed CPR until the North Ridgeville Fire Department arrived and took over the scene. Robert was placed onto gurney and was transported by EMS to St. John Medical Center in Westlake, OH.

I went inside and later found the Robert was staying in room 117. The door was open and officers saw there was large amounts of medications sitting around the room. The medications all had Robert's name on them. It appeared that Robert was based on the medications prescribed to him.

Robert's wheelchair and the rest of his belongings were secured in the room. Myself and Ptlm. McGraw followed up with Robert at the hospital. Robert was being worked on by medical staff, but at the time I arrived, he had a pulse and blood pressure.

Based on the statements given by the group of people who where outside of the Motel while performing CPR on Robert and his medical history, it appears that Robert only had a medical issue at this time. I observed no criminal activity while at the motel.

checked for ID. No ID was found, however medication with his name was. His name was forwarded to NRFD who later transported the male to SJWS Hospital. Officers followed up at SJWS Hospital and were told that the male was alive but we were not able to speak to him because they were still working on him. Ptlm.

- 3. FTO advised Ptlm. I on how to go in to evidence.com and tag videos appropriately. Ptlm. completed this with no issues.
- 4. Officers were dispatched to a Center Ridge Rd address for a report that the complainants' sister had hung herself. Ptlm. was right next to the address as we were dispatched. FTO went in to the apartment as Ptlm. was right next to the address as we were dispatched. FTO went in to the apartment as Ptlm. The complainant was performing CPR on the female in an upstairs bedroom. Sgt. Phillips took over CPR as Ptlm. The spoke with family and obtained information about the female. After speaking with family, Ptlm. The took pictures of the scene while waiting for the coroner to respond. Upon the coroner's arrival, information was passed along to him and Great Lakes removed the code 16 female. Information was obtained for a report which was completed in a timely manner. It should be noted that Ptlm. The handled this call like he has done this before. I did not have to tell him to speak to anyone, he did this on his own. This even caught Lt. Freas' attention.
- 5. Officers were dispatched to Patton Dr for a possible domestic violence complaint. Upon arrival, Officers were given the wrong address of where the noise was coming from. Officers were able to locate the correct house and spoke with a female who advised she did not need the police. The female also advised her and her boyfriend got in a verbal argument over coffee.

Most notable performance of the week:

Ptlm. most notable performance came on his first shift of this week. Ptlm was dispatched to Super 8 Motel in regards to an unresponsive male. Ptlm. was second on scene but once he arrived on scene he took over the scene. Ptlm. assisted Ptlm. Mobley in removing a male from a wheelchair, who was unresponsive with no pulse. Ptlm. CPR on the male and began ordering Ptlm. Mobley on what he needed from him. Ptlm. continued CPR until NRFD arrived on scene. The males room was checked in an attempt to identify him and then officers followed up at the hospital to check on the males welfare. Upon arrival at the hospital, it was learned the male was alive and had good numbers on heart rate and BP. Officers were unable to speak to him since doctors were still working on the male.

Most concerning performance of the week:

We are still working on Ptlm. geography of the city. He is continuing to improve each shift by remembering areas from previous night calls. Given the improvement, it is still a slow process given we are doing this at night.

### Additional comments:

Ptlm. is moving through FTO at a steady pace and quickly learning the NRPD way as opposed to how his other departments handled calls for service. Ptlm. has fit in nicely with night shift

### Some noteworthy points:
