The boathouse to be built hereon, is to be not more than 22 feet long, 13 feet wide, nor to extend higher than 5 feet higher than 5 feet above the standard water line of Turkey Foot Lake.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Commissioner of the Division of Conservation and Natural Resources and by said lessees. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.
