## Narrative:

On June 17, 2024, Special Agent (SA) Josh Rammel (Rammel) received the Incident Report from the Weston Emergency Medical Services (EMS) regarding their response to the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which took place on June 16, 2024, at 8401 South Dixie Highway, Rudolph, Ohio.

SA Rammel observed the following information included on the report that is important to the investigation.

The initial complaint was for "psychiatric problems/abnormal behavior/suicide attempt".

EMS was dispatched at 01:13:40 and arrived at 01:37:40 on June 16, 2024. EMS cleared the scene at 06:31:10.

The individuals listed as responding to the scene were Kathy Heyman (Heyman), Christy Korb (Korb), Mercy LifeFlight, Central Joint Fire Department, Cygnet Fire Department, and the Wood County Sheriff's Office (WCSO).

EMS performed resuscitation and additional medical attention including treating the fatal gunshot wound at the scene, but no transport was made.

Information provided that EMS was "staged" near the scene and that cardiac arrest was witnessed by the EMS after resuscitation efforts were performed.

EMS and Mercy LifeFlight continued with medical treatment until 03:42:00 when death was called by Korb.
