On August 28, 2023, as part of an ongoing investigation of an officer involved critical incident, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Crime Scene Technician (CST) Amy Gill retrieved evidence from the Franklin County Coroner's Office (FCCO).

At 0940 hours, CST Gill met with FCCO Morgue Supervisor Erika Wrigley and received a brown bag containing evidence from the autopsy of Jamie Overstreet. CST Gill returned to the Ohio BCI Office located in London, Ohio, where the evidence was packaged and labeled as the following:

Item #	Description
1	Fingernail kit from Jamie Overstreet
2	Bags from hands
3	CD containing photos from autopsy
4	FTA card from Jamie Overstreet
5	Projectile recovered from right neck during autopsy

At 1134 hours, CST Gill submitted item 5 to the BCI laboratory. Items 1-4 were placed into the BCI Temporary Evidence Locker #1 at 1138 hours to be submitted to the BCI major crimes evidence vault.
