DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Adjutant General and The Burnip Construction Company, which is a partnership composed of Phillip Burgess, W. F. Hopkins and C. A. Niple, of Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of the remodeling of Filtration Plant at Camp Perry, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of \$7,458.00 by the State of Ohio. It has been noted, however, that the total amount of the bid was \$12,750.00. However, the contractor looks to J. H. Nicholas, Disbursing Officer of the Federal Government for the difference between the contract bid and the amount the state agrees to pay.
