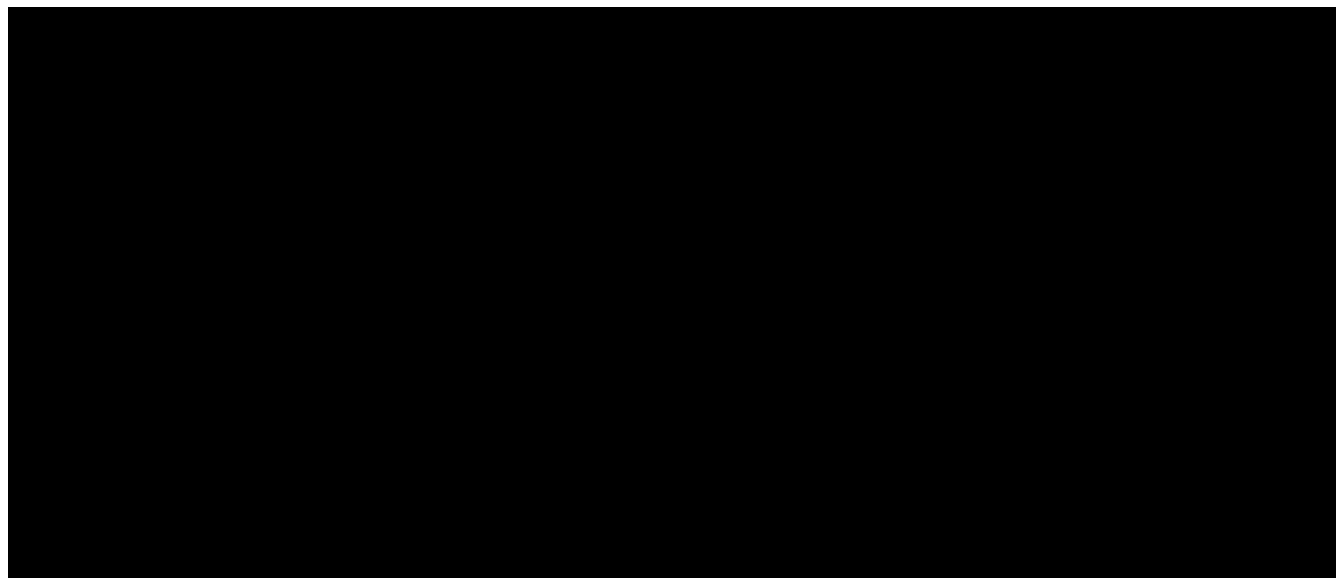
Narrative:

On Thursday, April 17, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received an email from the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office.
