The above purchase of bonds appears to be part of an issue of bonds of the above county dated October 1, 1936. The transcript relative to this issue was approved by this office in an opinion rendered to your board under date of October 2, 1936, being Opinion No. 6139.

It is accordingly my opinion that these bonds constitute a valid and legal obligation of said county.
