DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Superintendent of Public Works, for and on behalf of the Department of Public Welfare, and The W. H. Spohn Plumbing Company of Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of contract for Plumbing, Heating and Ventilating in a building known as Cottage “S” to be erected on a site of the Ohio Hospital for Epileptics, Gallipolis, Ohio, as set forth in Item No. 5, Item No. 18, Alternate P-3 and Item No. 19, Alternate P-4 of the Form of Proposal submitted March 6, 1930. Said contract calls for an expenditure of twelve thousand eight hundred and seventeen dollars (\$12,817.00).

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract.

You have also submitted evidence that the consent of the Controlling Board to the release of funds has been obtained in accordance with Section 11 of House Bill No. 510 of the 88th General Assembly. In addition, you have submitted a contract bond upon which the Globe Indemnity Company appears as surety, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.

You have further submitted evidence indicating that plans were properly prepared and approved, notice to bidders was properly given, bids tabulated as required
