Narrative:

On Tuesday, September 16, 2025, at approximately 1259 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent Steven Seitzman was notified by Special Agent Supervisor William Jones of an officer-involved critical incident that had occurred in Springfield, Clark County, Ohio.

SA Seitzman was advised that the involved subject, unidentified at that time, had been transported to Miami Valley Hospital in Dayton, Ohio. SA Seitzman responded to the hospital, arriving at approximately 1405 hours.

Upon arrival, SA Seitzman met with Springfield Police Detectives Kevin Miller and Paige Rector. Detective Miller identified the involved subject as Patrick Ray Foley. He advised that Foley had sustained facial injuries, a fractured skull, and a possible severed tongue. He further advised that Foley had been intubated.

Foley was transferred to the Intensive Care Unit and admitted to room 4539. Hospital staff advised that Foley was in critical condition.

Due to privacy concerns and the subject's inability to provide consent, SA Seitzman did not photograph Foley's injuries.

SA Seitzman departed Miami Valley Hospital at approximately 1530 hours.
