Narrative:

On September 22, 2025, Ohio BCI Special Agent Lauren Frazier (SA Frazier) received case-related records and documents from Springfield Police Lieutenant Beau Collins. 

The Affiant, Detective K Miller, being first sworn, says there is probable cause to believe the defendant, Patrick Ray Foley, committed an offense based on the summary of facts below:

On Tuesday September 16th, 2025 at approximately 1130 hours an Officer of the Springfield Police Division was conducting traffic enforcement about the city. The Officer was parked on the east side of the road next to 1322 S. Limestone Street, facing west, in a fully marked police vehicle while in the official police uniform.

The Officer checked the speed of a silver Ford F250 that was traveling northbound on S. Limestone Street from E. John Street. This Ford would later be discovered to be bearing Ohio temporary registration, T854050. The operator would later be identified as Patrick Foley. The Officer made note that the LIDAR clocked the speed of the truck at 62 mph in a posted 35 mph zone from 813 feet.

A traffic stop was then initiated by activating the patrol vehicle's overhead lights as the Ford passed. The Ford was originally in the curb lane, heading north, but then got into the far left lane. The Officer got behind the Ford and continued to attempt the traffic stop. The Ford truck turned westbound onto Southern Ave. and the Officer activated their siren, and Patrick continued to drive westbound, failing to stop. The Officer observed that the truck continue without stopping, passing two posted stop signs. At this time the Officer deactivated their overhead lights and discontinued the traffic stop.

The Ford truck then turn northbound onto an unknown road at which time the Officer did the same in an attempt to relocate the truck. While checking the area the truck was relocated parked on the east curb facing north in front of 522 S. Isabella St. The operator of the vehicle, Patrick Foley, was exiting the vehicle at that time.

The Officer made a U-turn on W. Pleasant St. near S. Isabella St. to get to the truck. While pulling up to the vehicle Patrick started walking away quickly. The Officer gave Patrick orders to stop. As he approached Patrick, Patrick jumped a fence and fled on foot to the southeast. Patrick would double back in the yard of 532 S. Isabella Street, heading north, before jumping the fence, causing him to stumble. Patrick got up and attempted to again flee on foot down an alley to the east. At this time the Officer deployed their Taser at which time Patrick fell forward to the ground in the alley way. While placing Patrick into handcuffs, Patrick's right hand contained a baggy holding a white rock like substance and US Currency. When Patrick was rolled over the Officer observed Patrick to have a facial injury and requested Medics. Other Officers arrived on scene and determined due to the distance of Medics they would transport Patrick to SRMC for treatment in a police van.

Patrick was found to not a have a valid Ohio Operators License.

Patrick was transported to SRMC and later to Miami Valley Hospital for injuries he sustained while fleeing the traffic stop.

I, Detective Kevin Miller, contacted the registered owner of the vehicle regarding its status. The registered owner advised the vehicle was being worked on due to it being inoperable and was not permitted to be driven by anyone.

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The Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was contacted to assist with the crime scene processing and investigation.

The Ford truck was towed and with a search warrant granted it was searched. Upon searching the vehicle Officers located a digital scale, plastic bags, several bags of suspected marijuana, bags of white powder substance, a bag of hard white substance, a suspected drug pipe, a prescription bottle with another person's name containing multiple prescription pills, and a cell phone.

A search warrant was granted to access the cell phone. Upon accessing the device there were multiple messages with Patrick discussing the location of meet-ups, prices, and amounts of prescription drugs, and "hardball" (street name for crack cocaine). Other activity also consistent with drug trafficking. The device was confirmed to be Patricks based on his Icloud information, photos of him, and people conversating with him and reaching out to "Pat".

Warrants are being requested for Patrick R. Foley for Unlawful use of a Motor Vehicle, Obstructing Official Business, Failure to Comply, Speed, and No Operators License. Additional charges regarding drug evidence are pending BCI testing and presentation to the Clark County Grand Jury.
