EASEMENTS—TO STATE BY SEVERAL PROPERTY OWNERS,
LAND, SOMERFORD, PLEASANT, DEER CREEK, UNION,
AND OAK RUN TOWNSHIPS, MADISON COUNTY, USE,
PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Somerford, Pleasant, Deer Creek, Union, Oak Run Townships, Madison County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said townships and county.
